Oppose	paul C burt	<p>I strongly oppose the continued allocation of taxpayer funds under Measure A for homeless services, given Los Angeles County's failure to account for billions previously spent with negligible impact on homelessness. The 2025-26 budget projects \$1.1B from Measure A, yet prior funds, including Measure H, have been blithely dispersed without transparent outcomes, as evidenced by LAHSA's criticized financial oversight (LAist, April 2025).</p> <p>The egregious involvement of labor unions like SEIU Local 721, AFSCME District Council 36, and LA County Federation of Labor in the Measure A Labor Council is particularly troubling. These organizations generate zero revenue, but rather specialize in the siphoning off wealth created by others, whether those others are the taxpayers or businesses. These and other groups prioritize self-interest over effective solutions, inflating costs without delivering ANYTHING in the way of results and their influence risks further mismanagement of taxpayer funds.</p> <p>I urge the Board to suspend all taxpayer-funded homeless services, including Measure A, until a comprehensive federal audit ensures accountability and efficacy. Without rigorous oversight, continued spending perpetuates waste and fails our unhoused population.</p> <p>Taxpayers, including seniors like myself, demand transparency, not unchecked disbursements. Halt Measure A funding and prioritize a federal audit now.</p>
