| | | Oppose | paul C burt | <p>While maintaining the utmost respect for the late Deputy Clinkunbroomer's service and with further respect extended to his survivors and colleagues, I strongly oppose Agenda Item 18 for the LABOS meeting on September 16, 2025.</p> <p>While the gesture of honoring the late Deputy Clinkunbroomer is noble, and I fully support it, Supervisor Barger's proposal to siphon off \$30,000 of Measure A funds for signage is an outrageous misuse of taxpayer money and a blatant disregard for the Will of the People.</p> <p>Los Angeles County voters passed Measure A in 2024 with a specific mandate: To fund homelessness services, "affordable housing", and prevention programs - Not to bankroll symbolic gestures like signage.</p> <p>The Board's recurring pattern of diverting taxpayer funds for non-essential projects mocks the electorate's clear mandate(s) and with over 75,000 unhoused residents and a looming fiscal crisis, this \$30,000 expenditure is indefensible.</p> <p>The proposed scholarship partnership, lacking transparent funding details, further risks misallocating public resources now and into the future.</p> <p>I demand Supervisor Barger and the Board stop this habitual misuse of taxpayer funds and honor Measure A's voter-approved purpose by finding alternative, non-taxpayer-funded ways to commemorate and honor, Deputy Clinkunbroomer.</p> |
