		Oppose	paul C burt	As a law abiding registered voter in Los Angeles County, I am VERY concerned by Agenda Item 16, seeking to suspend Board Rule 22.1 to discuss preparations for the November 4, 2025, special election on Governor Newsom's spite-driven, proposal for constitutional amendment for middecade redistricting; blaspehomous in and of itself in my opinion. Small question that Agenda Item 16 exceeds the Board's charter authority under Article III of the Los Angeles County Charter, which limits its legislative and executive roles to county governance and does not extend to directing or overseeing state-mandated election logistics - responsibilities assigned solely to the independent Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk per California Elections Code § 3000 et seq. and county operational protocols. Such medling and interference risks politicizing a nonpartisan process and diverting resources from essential local priorities, as evidenced by the Board's own historical avoidance of state election oversight (e.g., no prior instances in board minutes or charter precedents for directing RR/CC election reports). I urge rejection of this item to uphold the charter and election integrity.
