		Other	Paloma Bustos	<p>The report on the strategic plan for the 2028 Olympics was supposed to be heard today, but it was removed from the agenda. This plan is important, and the public deserves to know how the County will protect residents and workers as we prepare for these events.</p> <p>We understand the County is considering clearing encampments near Olympic venues. We are not opposed to people being connected to housing and services. Our concern is when encampments are cleared to make homelessness less visible for the Games, instead of making sure people are connected to stable, long-term housing and support they trust.</p> <p>When encampments are cleared without careful coordination, people can lose contact with outreach workers and service providers they rely on. This can increase their risk of exploitation and human trafficking. This risk is even greater as the County prepares for the World Cup and Olympics, because these events bring more construction and demand for low-paid, temporary workers. Housing instability makes people more vulnerable to being taken advantage of.</p> <p>FIFA and LA28 were required to submit human rights plans by December 31, but those plans have still not been made public. Without transparency, the community cannot see what protections will be in place to prevent exploitation and trafficking.</p> <p>We urge the County to make these plans public and to ensure that Olympic preparations focus on protecting people, connecting them to stable housing, and preventing exploitation and trafficking. Thank you.</p>
