Proclaiming October 23-31, 2025 as Red Ribbon Week in the County of Los Angeles

Red Ribbon Week, held annually from October 23 to October 31, is the nation's largest drug prevention awareness campaign. It began in 1985 to honor the memory of DEA agent Enrique "Kiki" Camarena, who lost his life in the fight against drug trafficking. In response, communities across the United States came together to raise awareness about the dangers of substance abuse and the importance of making healthy, drug-free choices. Today, Red Ribbon Week serves as a reminder of the collective effort needed to educate and inspire young people to live safe, productive, and drug-free lives.

Schools, community organizations, and families participate in Red Ribbon Week through a variety of activities designed to engage and empower youth. These can include classroom lessons, assemblies, themed dress-up days, poster contests, and pledge campaigns where students commit to staying drug-free. Many communities also hold rallies, parades, or awareness events to spread the message beyond the classroom and involve parents, local leaders, and law enforcement. The unifying symbol of the campaign is the red ribbon, worn or displayed to demonstrate support for a drug-free lifestyle and solidarity in promoting healthier communities.

Beyond the week itself, Red Ribbon Week encourages lasting conversations about health, safety, and personal responsibility. It provides an opportunity for parents,
