Proclaiming October 2025 as Italian American Heritage Month in Los Angeles County

The month of October has been recognized across the United States as Italian American Heritage Month, celebrating the rich history, cultural traditions, and extraordinary contributions of Italian Americans to the fabric of our nation.

Over 5.4 million Italians immigrated to the United States between 1820 and 2000, with over 26 million Americans of Italian descent living in the United States, making them the fifth largest ethnic group in the nation.

In Los Angeles County specifically, Italian American artists, entrepreneurs, civic leaders, and workers have made lasting contributions from architecture, to cuisine, to entertainment, to labor rights, enriching the diversity that makes Los Angeles County unique and vibrant.

Italian immigrants were instrumental in the development of the fishing industry in San Pedro, which became a cornerstone of Los Angeles County's economy. The County's official seal pays homage to this legacy by featuring a tuna fish, symbolizing the fishing and canning industries at the Port of Los Angeles and celebrating their influence on the County's maritime commerce and growth.

Today, San Pedro is home to approximately 45,000 Italian Americans, making it
