Pacific Palisades Taskforce on Hillside Homelessness Parking Fee Waiver

The Pacific Palisades Taskforce on Homelessness was established in 2014 by former Assemblymember Richard Bloom and Supervisor Sheila Kuehl to provide services and support for the unhoused population in the Pacific Palisades. The Taskforce partners with The People Concern to conduct outreach and provide critical services. As part of its ongoing efforts, the Taskforce conducts annual assessments and interventions on of the Pacific Palisades hillside, an area where unhoused individuals have historically established encampments. These efforts are primarily aimed at reducing fire risk and addressing safety concerns.

On October 22, 2025, 15 volunteers gathered at the Will Rogers Lifeguard Tower alongside representatives from The People Concern, Los Angeles Police Department, LA County Sheriff's Department, LA Recreation and Parks, California State Park Rangers, Council District 11, and the LA City Mayor's Office. Together, they conducted community engagement efforts in the hillside area to connect individuals experiencing homelessness with services and support.
