Reward Offer in the Investigation of Murder Victim Elijah Long

On Friday, September 27, 2024, at approximately 9:20 a.m., 42-year-old Elijah Long, was riding his motorcycle northbound on Atlantic Avenue, when a silver/light blue Toyota sedan driving southbound on Atlantic Avenue, made a left turn toward Arlington Avenue in front of Mr. Long, causing Mr. Long to collide into the Toyota sedan. The suspect driving the Toyota sedan then fled the scene of the collision going eastbound on Arlington Avenue and out of view. Mr. Long sustained fatal injuries from the collision and was pronounced deceased at the scene. Mr. Long is survived by his father and siblings.

The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD), Century Station Traffic Detectives believe there may be someone that knows who the suspect driving the Toyota sedan was and that feel that a reward in the amount of \$20,000 may encourage someone to come forward. Any individuals with information regarding this Fatal Hit and Run collision are urged to contact LASD Century Station Traffic Investigators or Crime Stoppers.
