For the 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Paris brought the festivities to life outside the sports venues, by broadcasting the events in 23 public places throughout all arrondissements, making the events accessible to Parisians and visitors alike. The 2028 Games present an opportunity to build a model for how these large-scale events can be opened up to Angelenos, turning beaches, parks, and landmarks into shared spaces for play, culture, and community. In response to the Board of Supervisors approved motion authored by Supervisor Horvath titled "88 for 28: Creating a Regional Approach for the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games", cities in the County of Los Angeles continue to meet on a quarterly basis to support coordinated planning and ensure a successful and inclusive experience for all communities across the county.

The third convening was held on October 30, 2025, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Board Hearing Room 381B, in downtown Los Angeles. Staff from LA28, the City of LA's Office of Major Events, CEO's Office, and Culver City presented on live sites and fan zones for the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games.
