Establish the Reward Offer in the Murder of David Bacon

On November 28, 2023, at approximately 6:26 a.m., Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) officers responded to Alondra Park, located in the unincorporated area of El Camino Village, regarding a report of a person in need of medical assistance. When deputies arrived at the park, they found the victim lying on the ground, covered in blood. The Los Angeles County Fire Department responded and pronounced the victim deceased at the scene. The victim was identified as David Bacon, a transgender female who had not fully transitioned and went by the name Brittany Lopez. During the course of the investigation, it was determined that the victim arrived at the park around 10:00 p.m., on November 27, 2023, and was not seen or heard from again until being discovered at the scene. An autopsy determined that the cause of death was blunt head trauma and that the manner of death was homicide. Detectives have conducted a thorough investigation and have exhausted all leads.

LASD Homicide Investigators believe it would be appropriate to offer a reward in this case to stimulate communication, bring attention to the incident, and cause the community to come forward with information that would lead to the identification of the suspect(s). Any individuals with information about this crime are urged to contact the LASD Homicide Bureau or Crime Stoppers.

I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

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Establish the offer of a reward in the amount of \$10,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the individuals responsible for the death of David Bacon, who was murdered between November 27, 2023, and November 28, 2023, in the unincorporated area of El Camino Village.
