**JOINT RESOLUTIONS BETWEEN THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AS THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, CONSOLIDATED FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, AND
COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT, VARIOUS COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICTS, AND
OTHER AFFECTED TAXING ENTITIES ACCEPTING THE NEGOTIATED EXCHANGE OF
PROPERTY TAX REVENUE AS A RESULT OF PROPOSED ANNEXATIONS TO COUNTY
SANITATION DISTRICTS
(ANNEXATION NOS. 14-454, 14-461, 14-464, 21-775, 21-776, 22-447, and SCV-1116)
(FIFTH DISTRICT)
(3-VOTES)**

SUBJECT

This action is to adopt the Negotiated Property Tax Exchange Joint Resolutions (Joint Resolutions) associated with the annexation of territories into County of Los Angeles (County) Sanitation Districts Nos. 14, 21, 22 and the Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County (Sanitation Districts).

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

1. Find that the proposed Joint Resolutions are not subject to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because the proposed actions do not meet the definition of a project for the reasons stated herein and the reasons reflected in the record.
2. Adopt Joint Resolutions between the Board of Supervisors (Board), as the governing body of the County, the Consolidated Fire Protection District, and the County Flood Control District, and on behalf of the LA County Library, County Waterworks District No. 40, and Road District No. 5; County Sanitation District No. 14, County Sanitation District No. 21, County Sanitation District No. 22 and the Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County; and other affected taxing entities

based on the negotiated exchange of property tax revenue related to proposed Annexation Nos. 14-454 and 14-464 in the City of Palmdale; No. 14-461 in the City of Lancaster; No. 21-775 in unincorporated West Claremont; No. 21-776 in the City of Claremont; No. 22-447 in the City of San Dimas; and No. SVC-1116 in the City of Santa Clarita.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

The governing bodies of the affected Sanitation Districts and the respective taxing entities have adopted the enclosed Joint Resolutions based on the negotiated exchange of property tax revenue related to the proposed annexations to the Sanitation Districts.

In order for the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) for the County to proceed with the required hearings on the proposed annexations, your Board, as the governing body of the County, Consolidated Fire Protection District, and the County Flood Control District, and on behalf of the LA County Library, County Waterworks District No. 40, and Road District No. 5, must also adopt the attached Joint Resolutions.

The proposed annexations involve residential, vacant, and commercial parcels for which there is no other local agency able to provide off-site sewage disposal services. The annexations will allow property owners in the affected territories to obtain off-site sewage disposal service from the Sanitation Districts by connecting their properties to existing sewer lines. Currently, the only option available to property owners is to construct private septic systems. In each annexation application submitted to LAFCO, all the owners of real properties within the affected territories have requested, in writing, that their properties be annexed to the respective Sanitation District.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

These actions support the County's Strategic Plan North Star 3 — Realize Tomorrow's Government Today — by strengthening our internal controls and processes while being cognizant of efficiency to continue good stewardship of the public trust and fiscal responsibility.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

There is no base transfer of property taxes associated with these annexations. If the annexations are approved, the adopted Joint Resolutions will transfer a portion of the annual property tax growth attributable to the annexation areas from the County, Consolidated Fire Protection District, County Flood Control District, and the other affected taxing entities to the affected Sanitation Districts. The impact of the annexations to the County's share of incremental property tax growth for future years due to the proposed annexations is minimal and is reflected in the Enclosure.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Pursuant to Part 3, Division 3, Title 5 of the California Government Code, commencing with section 56000, the Sanitation Districts adopted resolutions and filed applications with LAFCO to initiate proceedings for the reorganization of territory to the Sanitation Districts. Section 99 of the Revenue and Taxation Code (R&T Code) requires that prior to the effective date of any jurisdictional change, the governing bodies of all agencies whose service area, or service responsibilities will be altered by such change, must negotiate a reallocation of property tax revenue between the affected agencies, and approve and accept such reallocation by resolution. The Sanitation Districts and the other

independent taxing entities have adopted the negotiated Joint Resolutions for the subject reorganizations, as required by section 99 of the R&T Code.

Adoption of the Joint Resolutions by your Board will allow LAFCO to schedule the required public hearings to consider testimony on the proposed reorganizations. LAFCO will subsequently take action to approve, approve with changes, or disapprove the proposals for reorganizations.

The Joint Resolutions have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

The proposed actions are not projects pursuant to CEQA, because they are activities excluded from the definition of a project by section 15378(b) of the State CEQA Guidelines. The proposed actions create a government funding mechanism, a fiscal activity which does not involve any commitment to any specific project, which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

The proposed action has no impact on current County services or projects.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 99 and 99.01 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, prior to the effective date of any jurisdictional change which will result in a special district providing a new service, the governing bodies of all local agencies that receive an apportionment of the property tax from the area must determine the amount of property tax revenues from the annual tax increment to be exchanged between the affected agencies and approve and accept the negotiated exchange of property tax revenues by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of the agencies signatory hereto have made determinations of the amount of property tax revenues from the annual tax increments to be exchanged as a result of the annexation to County Sanitation District No. 14 entitled *Annexation No. 454*;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The negotiated exchange of property tax revenues resulting from the annexation of territory to County Sanitation District No. 14 in the annexation entitled *Annexation No. 454* is approved and accepted.

2. For each fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2023, or after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the County Auditor shall transfer to County Sanitation District No. 14 a total of 0.3248025 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within *Annexation No. 454* as shown on the attached Worksheet.

3. No additional transfer of property tax revenues shall be made from any other tax agencies to County Sanitation District No. 14 as a result of annexation entitled Annexation No. 454.

4. No transfer of property tax increments from properties within a community redevelopment project, which are legally committed to a Community Redevelopment Agency, shall be made during the period that such tax increment is legally committed for repayment of the redevelopment project costs.

5. If at any time after the effective date of this resolution, the calculations used herein to determine initial property tax transfers or the data used to perform those calculations are found to be incorrect thus producing an improper or inaccurate property tax transfer, the property tax transfer shall be recalculated and the corrected transfer shall be implemented for the next fiscal year.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 99 and 99.01 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, prior to the effective date of any jurisdictional change which will result in a special district providing a new service, the governing bodies of all local agencies that receive an apportionment of the property tax from the area must determine the amount of property tax revenues from the annual tax increment to be exchanged between the affected agencies and approve and accept the negotiated exchange of property tax revenues by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of the agencies signatory hereto have made determinations of the amount of property tax revenues from the annual tax increments to be exchanged as a result of the annexation to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District entitled *Annexation No. 1116*;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The negotiated exchange of property tax revenues resulting from the annexation of territory to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District in the annexation entitled *Annexation No. 1116* is approved and accepted.

2. For each fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2023, or after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the County Auditor shall transfer to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District a total of 0.9071904 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within Annexation *No. 1116* for Tax Rate Area 09125 as shown on the attached Worksheet.

3. For each fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2023, or after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the County Auditor shall transfer to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District a total of 0.9104050 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within Annexation *No. 1116* for Tax Rate Area 09142 as shown on the attached Worksheet.

4. For each fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2023, or after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the County Auditor shall transfer to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District a total of 0.9612003 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within Annexation *No. 1116* for Tax Rate Area 09960 as shown on the attached Worksheet.

5. For each fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2023, or after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the County Auditor shall transfer to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District a total of 0.9068830 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within Annexation *No. 1116* for Tax Rate Area 10683 as shown on the attached Worksheet.

6. For each fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2023, or after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the County Auditor shall transfer to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District a total of 0.9610902 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within Annexation *No. 1116* for Tax Rate Area 09133 as shown on the attached Worksheet.

7. For each fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2023, or after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the County Auditor shall transfer to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District a total of 0.9610902 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within Annexation *No. 1116* for Tax Rate Areas 14220 and 14228 as shown on the attached Worksheet.

8. No additional transfer of property tax revenues shall be made from any other tax agencies to Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District as a result of annexation entitled Annexation *No. 1116*.

9. No transfer of property tax increments from properties within a community redevelopment project, which are legally committed to a Community Redevelopment Agency, shall be made during the period that such tax increment is legally committed for repayment of the redevelopment project costs.

10. If at any time after the effective date of this resolution, the calculations used herein to determine initial property tax transfers or the data used to perform those calculations are found to be incorrect thus producing an improper or inaccurate property tax transfer, the property tax transfer shall be recalculated and the corrected transfer shall be implemented for the next fiscal year.




