RESOLUTION NO. 25-5840

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE CITY, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION ON TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2026, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY AS REQUIRED BY PROVISIONS OF THE CITY CHARTER

WHEREAS, under the law relating to charter cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on March 3, 2026 for the election of Municipal Officers:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the requirements of the Charter, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Temple City, California, on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, a General Municipal Election (election) for the purpose of electing Council Members for a full four-year term.

SECTION 2. The ballot to be used for the election shall be in the form and content as required by law.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to coordinate with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to procure and furnish any and all voter files, signature files, precinct files, procure agreements, battot drop-off box rentals, supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 4. The vote in person locations for the election shall be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. on February 28 (Saturday), March 1 (Sunday), and March 2 (Monday) and 7:00 a.m. to 8 p.m. on March 3 (Tuesday) the day of the election, pursuant to Election Code § 10242, except as provided in § 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 5. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by the City Charter, any ordinance or resolution felated to the City's General Municipal Election, and California law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 6. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give such further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

SECTION 7. That pursuant to Elections Code § 12310, compensation for services for election workers shall be fixed at the sum as determined by the City Clerk. The compensation for each election worker and backup worker to attend training class(es) shall be fixed at the sum as determined by the City Clerk. If full-time city employee are utilized as election workers (City Employee Election Workers), employees will receive their regular pay plus overtime or

compensatory time for hours worked beyond normal workdays / workweek consistent with any applicable MOU. City Employee Election Worker means a city employee who works at a voting location designated by the City Clerk during the voting period; a city employee who works at City Hall on Election Day that assists voters; or a city employee on Election Night that assist and prepare ballots for tabulation.

SECTION 8. The City Council authorizes the City Clerk to administer said Election and all reasonable and actual election expenses shall be paid by the City upon presentation of a properly submitted bill.

SECTION 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption hereof.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE CITY, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2026

WHEREAS,

- A. A standalone General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Temple City, California, on Tuesday, March 3, 2026.
- B. In the course of conduct of the Election it is necessary for the City to request services of the Los Angeles County Registrar/Recorder's Office.
- C. Time is of the essence to receive specified services at agreed-upon deadlines.
- D. All necessary expenses in performing service shall be paid by the City of Temple City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of California Elections Code Section 10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles to permit the County Election Department to prepare and furnish, at the request of the City and their authorized vendors for use in conducting the election, computer data consisting of the names and addresses and current precinct of all eligible registered voters in the City of Temple City in order that the City may print labels for mailing and/ or by electronic mail the Voter Information/Sample Ballot pamphlet to all registered voters in the City and for processing vote by mail ballots; provide other services, which may include consolidation of precincts as directed by the City; and to make available to the City additional election equipment including permanent and temporary Ballot Drop Boxes within City limits and assistance according to State law.

SECTION 2. The City shall reimburse the County for services performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is directed to forward to both the Board of Supervisors and the Los Angeles County Registrar/Recorder's Department a certified copy of this resolution.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption hereof.
