Other	Esroruleh Mohammad	<p>The status report for the Probation Department reflects urgent and ongoing safety risks for youth, including preventable harms linked to delayed care coordination, workforce constraints, and inconsistent cross-agency communication. These patterns align with upstream-to-downstream risk conditions documented throughout 2025, including gaps in prevention architecture, trauma-response capacity, and classification structures that restrict timely intervention.</p> <p>To strengthen outcomes at Los Padrinos and across the youth safety continuum, I respectfully recommend that future reports incorporate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A prevention-to-outcome pathway identifying system breakpoints;• Classification and workforce barriers that impede timely response;• A cross-department alignment plan linking DHS, DMH, DPH, Probation, Education, and Youth Development. <p>These elements already appear across County reform discussions and would improve transparency, accountability, and safety for youth receiving County care.</p> <p>Respectfully submitted, Dr. Esroruleh T.
