Other	Esroruleh Mohammad	The Continuum-of-Care program requires consistent, multi-year funding to prevent avoidable transitions into homelessness, violence, addiction, hunger, hospitalization, or crisis. Across 2025, County proceedings have documented that unstable funding disrupts service access, weakens prevention capacity, and undermines outcomes for individuals who rely on coordinated care. As the Board advances federal advocacy, I respectfully recommend including: • A prevention-pathway description mapping where individuals lose access to services; • Workforce and classification constraints contributing to those gaps; • A provenance review to ensure alignment between local implementation logic and federal expectations.
