

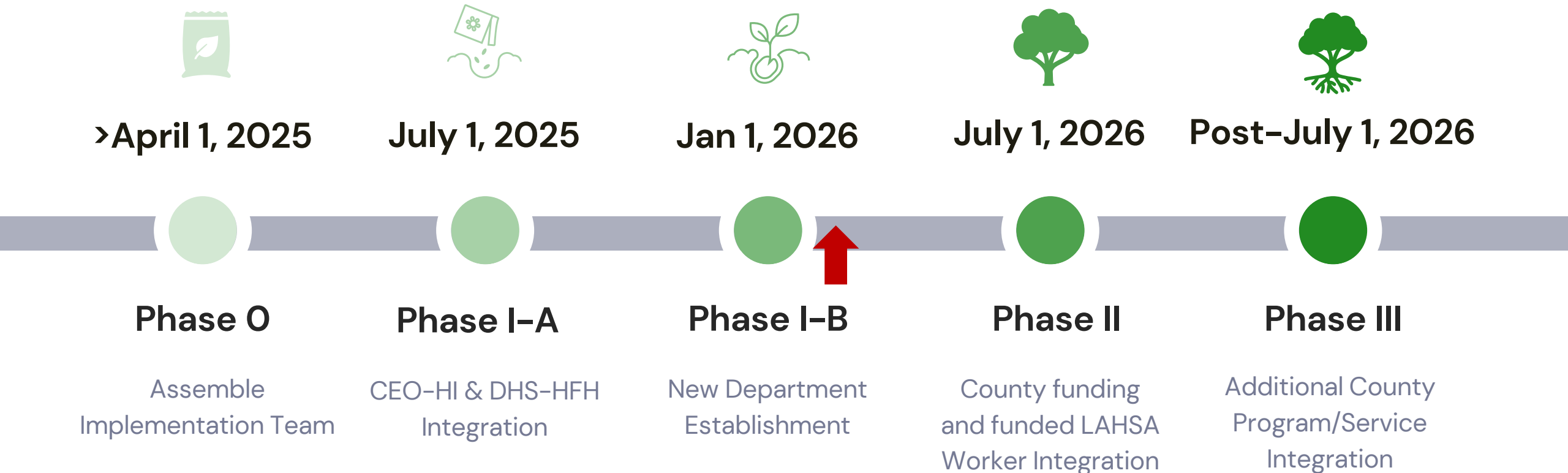

Takeaways

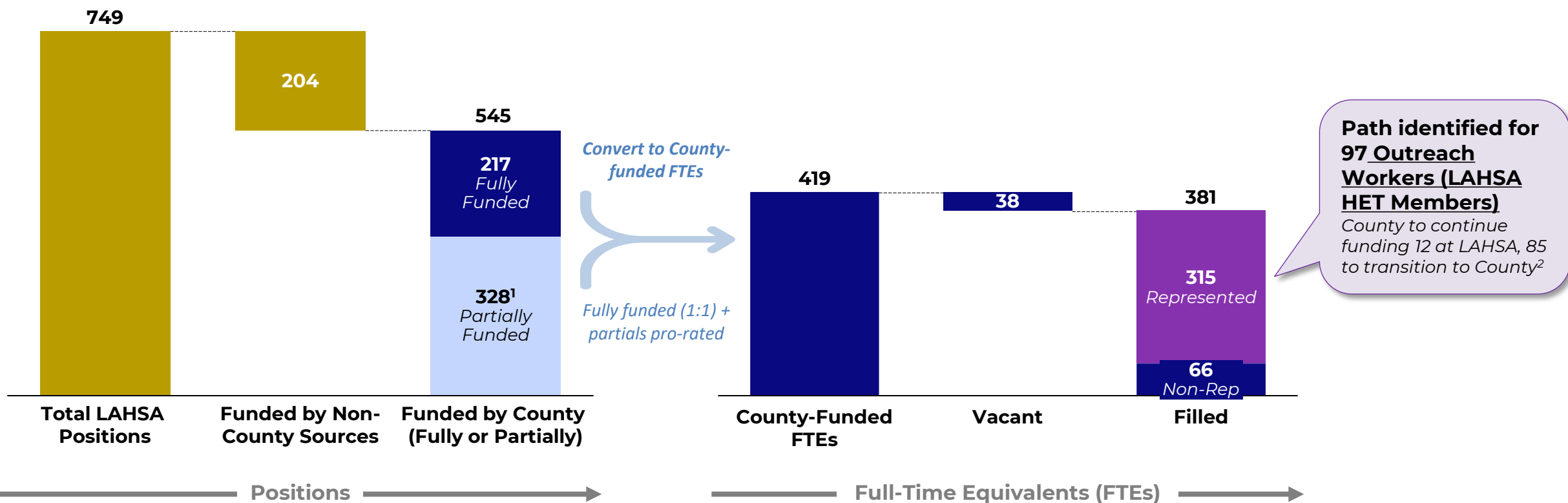
- **Number of Represented LAHSA Workers**

- Currently, LA County funds 315 represented FTEs, including 97 Outreach Workers
- Post July 1, 2026, LA County intends to fund 12 Outreach Workers at LAHSA
 - Prioritizing Outreach Workers, we identified 85 County CHW vacancies – 50 at DMH, 30 at HSH, 2 at DHS, & 3 at Probation
 - We will identify pathways for 218 County-funded represented LAHSA Workers

LAHSA Staff Breakdown

as of December 31, 2025

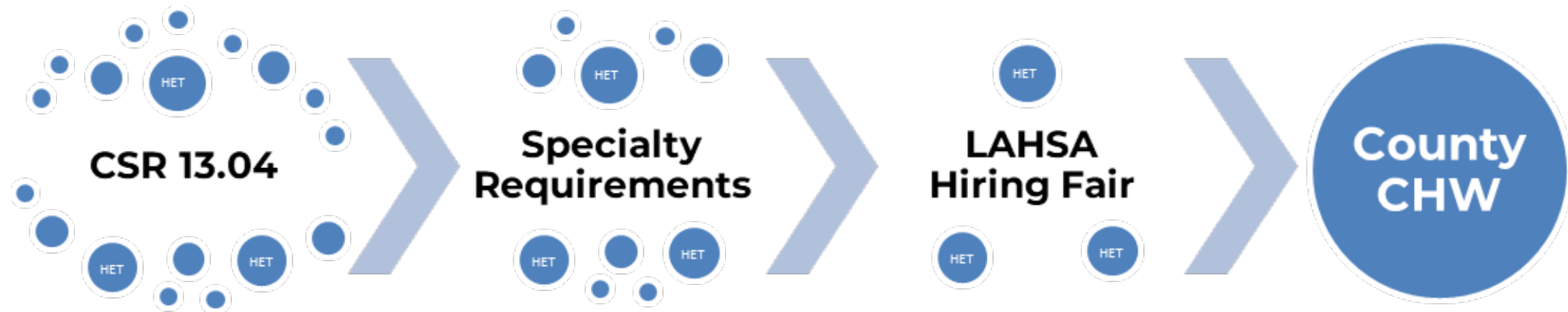
Absent FY 26-27 staffing plans from LAHSA, the County is planning based on FTEs it funds — and we now have a path forward for 97 of 315 represented FTEs



¹ Partially funded positions are converted to County-funded FTEs by pro-rating the County's share of each position. As a result, the 328 partially funded positions equate to 202 FTEs.

Prioritization Strategy for Outreach Workers

Objective: Hire up to 85 LAHSA Outreach Workers as County Community Health Workers



Action Steps

- **January/February**

- Resume meet and consult with Labor on specialty requirements for recruitment bulletin for LAHSA Outreach Workers & other represented job families
- Targeted webinar and one-stop hiring fairs for current LAHSA Outreach Workers

- **March/April**

- Complete consultations with Labor on represented job families
- Additional targeted webinars and one-stop hiring fairs for LAHSA workers
