## **Public comment item 58-City of Huntington Park Election**

Honorable Chair & Supervisors,

My name is Karina Macias, councilmember for the beautiful City of Huntington Park. I was present at the meeting today but due to caregiver duties I could not stay longer, and I was waiting online but I will soon need to head to my own council meeting.

I am addressing you today representing many in the community that have expressed concerns and opposition on the election date change on your agenda today. In the past 5 months, a 3 square mile community has been divided in voting districts; an election already proposed in June of this year was abruptly changed last minute—weeks leading up to candidacy papers were to be ready; and council majority is pushing an unexpired seat into a district election when it was a seat voted at-large. There are serious legal ramifications that are not being considered by my colleagues given that there is legal precedent with a Quo Warranto opinion on a similar matter in the City of Moreno Valley. Supervisors, I urge you to truly consider voting against this item. It is not a good look when the county registrar website already is listing this proposed election change when the vote is taking place today. I urge you NOT to extend my time unnecessarily, there is no legal reasons for this change. I am not comfortable staying longer than what the community voted for, that is not democracy.
