Response to Presidential Executive Order No. 14377 Preempting and Replacing State and Local Permitting Processes for Palisades and Eaton Fire Rebuilds

I, **THEREFORE, MOVE** that the Board of Supervisors direct County Counsel, in coordination with the Department of Public Works, the Department of Regional Planning, and the Office of Emergency Management, to monitor the implementation of the recently issued Presidential Executive Order No. 14377 directing the Secretary of Homeland Security, acting through the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and the Administrator of the Small Business Association, to preempt and replace State and local permitting processes, and other similar pre-approval requirements, for the rebuilding of structures impacted by the Palisades and Eaton Fires. County Counsel shall provide periodic updates in writing to the Board of Supervisors, as necessary.

I, **FURTHER, MOVE** that the Board of Supervisors authorize County Counsel to initiate or participate in litigation, or amicus filings, aimed at protecting the County's local land use and permitting authority, or any other actions, related to Presidential Executive Order No. 14377.
