At its meeting of January 27, 2026, the Paramount City Council adopted the following resolutions related to the City's General Municipal Election scheduled for June 2, 2026:

RESOLUTION NO. 26:001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 2, 2026 FOR THE ELECTION OF TWO (2) MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to General Law Cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on June 2, 2026 for the election of Municipal Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitation is true and correct.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Paramount, California, on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing two (2) Members of the City Council elected at-large for the full term of four (4) years.

SECTION 3. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to coordinate with the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk ("County Registrar") to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 5. The vote centers, operated by the County Registrar, for the election shall be open as required during the identified voting period pursuant to Sections 4005, 14212 and 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 6. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.


SECTION 7. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk and County Registrar are authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form, and manner as required by law.

SECTION 8. The City Council authorizes the City Clerk, in coordination with the County Registrar, to administer said election and all reasonable and actual election expenses shall be paid by the City upon presentation of a properly submitted bill.

SECTION 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


SECTION 10. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 26:002

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE PERTAINING TO CANDIDATE STATEMENTS SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 2, 2026

WHEREAS, Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of any local agency adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for a municipal election, including costs of the Candidate Statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitation is true and correct.

SECTION 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS. Pursuant to Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California, each candidate for elective office to be voted for at an election to be held in the City of Paramount on June 2, 2026 may prepare a Candidate Statement on an appropriate form provided by the City Clerk. The statement may include the name, age and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate himself or herself. The statement shall not include party affiliation of the candidate, nor membership or activity in partisan political organizations. The statement shall be filed in typewritten and digital form in the office of the City Clerk at the time the candidate's nomination papers are filed. The Candidate Statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the period for filing nomination papers and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

SECTION 3. FOREIGN LANGUAGE POLICY. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, candidate's statements will be translated into all languages required by the County of Los Angeles. The County will print and mail voter information guides and candidate's statements to all voters in English. The County will mail separate voter information guides and candidate's statements in the required languages only those voters who are on the county voter file as having requested a voter information guide in a particular language. The County will make the voter information guides and candidate's statements in the required languages available at all polling places/vote centers, on the County's website, and in the Elections Official's office.

SECTION 4. PAYMENT. For Candidate Statements to be printed in the Official Sample Ballot Booklet, the City Clerk shall work with the County Registrar to estimate the total cost of printing, handling, translating, and mailing the Candidate Statements filed, including costs incurred as a result of complying with the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, and require each candidate filing a Candidate Statement to pay in advance to the City of Paramount their estimated pro rata share as a condition of having their statement included in the Official Sample Ballot Booklet. The estimate is just an approximation of the actual cost that varies from one election to another election and may be significantly more or less than the estimate, depending on the actual number of candidates filing statements. Accordingly, the City Clerk is not bound by the estimate and may, on a pro rata basis, bill the candidate for additional actual expense or refund any excess paid depending on the final actual cost. In the event of underpayment, the City Clerk may require the candidate to pay the balance of the cost incurred. In the event of overpayment, the City Clerk shall prorate the excess amount among the candidates and refund the excess amount paid.

SECTION 5. ELECTRONIC DISTRIBUTION. Pursuant to Section 13307(c) of the California Elections Code, the governing body of the City of Paramount authorizes the preparation of candidate statements for nonpartisan elective office for the purpose of electronic distribution. Candidates may prepare statements for electronic distribution pursuant to Section 13307(a) of the Elections Code. A statement prepared pursuant to this subdivision shall be posted on the internet website of the County Elections Official.

Pursuant to Section 13307.7(a) of the Elections Code, candidates shall provide advance payment of the requisite fee to cover the duties and procedures set forth in Sections 13307(b) and (d) of the Elections Code. When a candidate submits a Candidate Statement to be printed in the Official Sample Ballot Booklet pursuant to Section 4 of this resolution, electronic distribution shall be included and no additional cost.

SECTION 6. MISCELLANEOUS. Translations shall be provided by professionally-certified translators and the City Clerk and County Registrar shall comply with all recommendations and standards set forth by the California Secretary of State regarding occupational designations and other matters relating to elections.

SECTION 7. ADDITIONAL MATERIALS. No candidate will be permitted to include additional materials in the Official Sample Ballot Booklet.

SECTION 8. The City Clerk shall provide each candidate or the candidate's representative a copy of this resolution at the time nominating petitions are issued.

SECTION 9. All previous resolutions establishing City Council policy on payment for Candidate Statements are repealed.

SECTION 10. This resolution shall apply at the next ensuing municipal election and at each municipal election after that time

SECTION 11. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it in the book of original resolutions.

SECTION 12. This Resolution shall take effective immediately upon its adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 26:003

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO CONSOLIDATE THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT'S GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 2, 2026 WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION ON THE SAME DATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 10403 OF THE CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Paramount called a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2026 for the purpose of the election of two (2) at-large Members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City of Paramount the precincts, vote centers and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk "County Registrar" canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARAMOUNT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitations are true and correct.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to the requirements of §10403 of the California Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, for the purpose of the election two (2) Members of the City Council elected at-large for the full term of office, and that the County of Los Angeles take all necessary steps to hold a consolidated election.

SECTION 3. The City Council adopted Resolution No. 26:001 on January 27, 2026 calling and ordering to be held in the City of Paramount, California, on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing two (2) Members of the City Council elected at-large for the full term of four (4) years.

SECTION 4. The City Council requests the Board of Supervisors to direct the County Registrar to administer, manage and perform all necessary functions, services and tasks related to the complete and successful conduct of the consolidated election; including the provision of all election materials and equipment; the hiring, training and supervision of poll workers and other election personnel; the printing and distribution of ballot materials; the translation of ballot materials in the required languages for the City of Paramount; the collection of submitted ballots; the tallying of votes; and canvassing of election results.

SECTION 5. The foregoing notwithstanding, County Registrar's services shall not include final declaration of the results by the City Council pursuant to Elections Code Sections 10262 through 10265.

SECTION 6. That the county election department is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used. The election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the statewide or special election.

SECTION 7. The candidate nomination and filing process shall occur in the City of Paramount for convenience of residents between the dates of February 9, 2026 and March 6, 2026, unless extended to March 11, 2026, in the event that an incumbent does not file, and shall be conducted by the City Clerk with the support of the County Registrar.

SECTION 8. The vote centers, operated by the County Registrar, for the election shall be open as required during the identified voting period pursuant to Sections 4005, 14212, and 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 9. In all particulars not otherwise specifically provided in this Resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law.


SECTION 10. The City of Paramount recognizes that expenses will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for these costs.

SECTION 11. The City Council directs the City Clerk to file a certified copy of this resolution with the County Registrar and the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 12. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.


SECTION 13. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
