So work with CEO and EO to redefine the board directed priority from child protection to child youth and family well-being and direct the OCP to change their name, which is wild to the Office of Child Youth and Family well-being.

And then really, with all of this, it's a focus.

Prevention, which really is in line with everything that we've been hearing from the board particularly I think what all five board members talked about during the budget hearings when DCFS and DPSS presented about how to make sure that we're focusing on kids and families as.

A means of prevention into county systems.

This motion I don't need to read through all the directives for you.

All you can read but.

And includes some accounting accountability mechanisms.

It asks all county departments and initiatives that provide direct services to children, youth and families.

To operationalize the redefined board directed priority through planning, budget making and performance alignment, and one change we have already made here is by the end of not this fiscal year but next fiscal year to give people more time to do that.

It asked the departments to prepare work plans to discuss how they are going to do all this.

So that's it.

We really appreciate it.

We think it does a great job of reflecting the recommendations that we made based on our listening sessions.

You know, OCP has been doing work towards well-being and prevention for a long time. So we're excited about this potential name change that we think really just.

Brings the need in line with the work that we've been doing with the support of the board. If adopted, we really see it moving us toward a coordinated prevention first system clear across department alignment performance measures tied to family stability and a stronger connection between economic supports and.

Child well-being, we see this as a structural alignment step, not just a symbolic change.

And it really responds directly to community input and positions the county for more coordinated implementation.
