Order Biennial Governing Board Election

February 12, 2026

RESOLVED that pursuant to Education Code (EC) §5000-5030 the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Debra Duardo, is hereby ORDERED to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following Specifications of the Election Order made under the authority of EC §5302, §5304 and §5322.

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

The election shall be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2026. The polling hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the District the question of which three (4) members shall be elected to the Board of Trustees of the Compton Unified School District, specifically, one member in each of Trustee Areas A, B, E, and G.

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder) will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for and holding of the above-mentioned election. The Compton Unified School District will pay the costs of the election. If any agency holds an election on June 2, 2026, the Compton Unified School District shall pay its pro rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election and shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes.

Pursuant to Section 13307(c) of the California Elections Code, the governing body of the Compton Unified School District authorizes the preparation of candidate statements for nonpartisan elective office for the purpose of electronic distribution. Candidates will prepare statements for electronic distribution pursuant to Section 13307(a) of the Elections Code. A statement prepared pursuant to this subdivision shall be posted on the internet website of the County Elections Official. Pursuant to Section 13307.7(a) of the Elections Code, candidates shall provide payment of the requisite fee to cover the duties and procedures set forth in Sections 13307(b) and (d) of the Elections Code. Consistent with the Board's Resolution No. 20/21-01-Regarding the Filing of Candidate Statements for District Elections approved in 2020, the maximum word limitation for candidate statements is 400 words.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the District is hereby directed to furnish two copies of this order to the County Superintendent not less than 57 days prior to the date set for the election.
