LA Climate Week: Financing the Climate Future Event Parking Fee Waiver

On March 17, 2026, the Board of Supervisors approved a [motion](#) proclaiming April 8–15, 2026, as Los Angeles Climate Week (LACW). LACW is a community-led initiative that brings together residents, educators, youth, nonprofit organizations, businesses, cultural institutions, and public agencies to collaborate on climate action and environmental stewardship. Throughout the week, there will be dozens of events, conversations, and educational programs open to the public across the County.

The Larta Institute, Creative Visions Foundation, and Collidescope Foundation are hosting one such LACW event on April 14, 2026, from 3:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., titled “Financing the Climate Future: From Breakthroughs to Deployment,” in Malibu. This event will bring together investors, funders, founders, and policy leaders to examine how financial systems can support the transition to a climate-resilient economy. The program will include three expert panels, and the event is open to the public.

Attendees are encouraged to take public transit or carpool. Waiving parking fees will help remove financial barriers for members of the public who wish to attend.
