Re-establish and Increase the Reward Offer in the Murder of David Bacon

On November 28, 2023, at approximately 6:26 a.m., Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) officers responded to Alondra Park, located in the unincorporated area of El Camino Village, regarding a report of a person in need of medical assistance. Upon arrival, deputies discovered the victim lying on the ground, covered in blood. The Los Angeles County Fire Department responded and pronounced the victim deceased at the scene.

The victim was identified as David Bacon, a transgender female who had not fully transitioned and went by the name Brittany Lopez. During the course of the investigation, detectives determined that the victim arrived at the park at approximately 10:00 p.m. on November 27, 2023, and was not seen or heard from again until being discovered the following morning. An autopsy concluded that the cause of death was blunt head trauma and the manner of death was homicide. Detectives have conducted a thorough investigation and have exhausted all leads.

LASD Homicide Investigators believe that re-establishing the reward in this case would help generate new information, encourage community engagement, and assist in identifying the suspect(s). This reward was originally established on November 18, 2025; however, it has since expired and needs to be re-established.
