**RESOLUTION OF THE LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT,
COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDERING A REGULAR
GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTION AND CONSTITUTING
"SPECIFICATION OF THE ELECTION ORDER"
TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026**

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Community College District (the "District") has previously adopted its Resolution aligning Governing Board elections with City of Los Angeles elections and Order approved August 10, 2016 (collectively, the "Alignment Resolution"); and

WHEREAS, the Alignment Resolution has been accepted by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (the "Registrar-Recorder") and Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools ("County Superintendent"); and

WHEREAS the Alignment Resolution complies with the provisions of Statutes of 2015, Chapter 235 ("SB 415"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Alignment Resolution and SB 415, the County Superintendent has called for a Regular Governing Board Member Election for Board of Trustees Seats 2, 4 and 6 to be held in this District on November 3, 2026; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 5322, whenever an election is ordered, the Governing Board of the district shall, not less than 123 days prior to the date set for the election, by resolution delivered to the County Superintendent and the officer conducting the election, specify the date of the election, the purpose of the election, the authority for ordering the election, the authority for the specifications of the election order, and the signature of the officer or the Clerk of the Board by law authorized to make the designations therein contained; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code Section 5016, the Governing Board shall determine the winner by lot in the event of a tie vote; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the Los Angeles Community College District does hereby resolve pursuant to Education Code (EC) §§5000-5030, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby ORDERED to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following Specifications of the Election Order made under the authority of EC §5302, §5304, and §5322.

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

1. The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026.
2. The purpose of the election is to elect members for Board of Trustees Seats 2, 4 and 6.
3. The Registrar-Recorder will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for and holding of the above-mentioned election. The District will pay the costs of the election. If any agency holds an election on November 3, 2026, the District shall pay its pro rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election and shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes.
4. As District policy, the candidates' statements of qualifications is increased to 400 words.
5. As District policy, the candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidate's statement, including any required foreign languages, in the voters' pamphlet. In accordance with the Registrar-Recorder estimate of the total cost of printing, handling, translating, and mailing the candidates' statements filed pursuant to this section, including costs incurred as a result of complying with the Voting Rights Act of 1965 (as amended), the District and/or the Registrar-Recorder, as appropriate, shall require each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance his or her estimated pro rata share as a condition of having his or her statement included in the voter's pamphlet. The estimate is an approximation of the actual cost that varies from one election to another election and may be significantly more or less than the estimate, depending on the actual number of candidates filing statements. Accordingly, the District and/or the Registrar-Recorder, as appropriate, are not bound by the estimate and may, on a pro rata basis, bill the candidate for additional actual expense or refund any excess paid depending on the final actual cost. In the event of underpayment, the candidate shall pay the balance of the cost incurred. In the event of overpayment, the District and/or the Registrar-Recorder, as appropriate, shall refund the excess amount paid within 30 days after the election.
6. It is further ordered that the Clerk or General Counsel of the District is hereby directed to furnish two copies of this order to the County Superintendent not less than 130 days prior to the date set for the election with the designation of two newspapers for the public notice election announcement for the Registrar-Recorder as attached.

The foregoing Resolution and Order was adopted and affirmed by the Governing Board of Los Angeles Community College District of Los Angeles County, being the Board authorized by law to make the designations contained therein, by formal vote as follows:
