Center for Strategic Partnerships 10th Anniversary

The Center for Strategic Partnerships (Center) was established in October 2015 through a motion by Supervisor Hilda L. Solis and Supervisor Sheila Kuehl, which directed the creation of the Center for Strategic Public-Private Partnerships within the Office of Child Protection. The Center officially launched in April 2016 with a mission to bridge Los Angeles County government and the philanthropic community, recognizing that the power of public-private partnerships had been under-utilized by the County and should be an important strategy for improving the lives of vulnerable children, youth, and families.

After demonstrating significant impact just two years into an initial three-year pilot, the Center was made permanent within the Chief Executive Office by a 2018 Board motion also sponsored by Supervisor Solis, expanding its scope to serve all Board Directed Priorities. The Center has served as a vital engine of innovation and collaboration for Los Angeles County, mobilizing philanthropic investment and community expertise to advance landmark efforts. Over its first ten years, the Center has engaged in more than 30 initiatives with over 50 partners, leveraging philanthropy and public resources to tackle the County’s most pressing challenges across child
