**Proclaiming April 17<sup>th</sup> as Cambodian Genocide Remembrance Day**

April 17, 2026 marks the 51<sup>st</sup> anniversary of the fall of Phnom Penh in 1975, which ushered in a period of profound suffering, loss, and displacement for the Cambodian people under the Khmer Rouge regime. During this tragic era, millions of Cambodians lost their lives, and countless families were torn apart.

Los Angeles County is home to one of the largest Cambodian communities outside of Cambodia, many of whom are survivors and descendants of those impacted by these atrocities. This day serves as an opportunity to honor their resilience, remember those who were lost, and educate future generations about the importance of human rights, justice, and the prevention of genocide.

**I, THEREFORE, MOVE** that the Board of Supervisors proclaim April 17, 2026 as Cambodian Genocide Remembrance Day in Los Angeles County, in honor of those killed in the genocide, the survivors, and their descendants for their courage and contributions to the County of Los Angeles.
