Order of Election of Keppel Union School District of Los Angeles County, California

RESOLUTION ORDERING GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTION

RESOLVED that pursuant to Education Code (EC) 5000-5030, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby **ORDERED** to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following specifications of the Election Order made under the authority of Education Code Sections 5302, 5304 and 5322.

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026.


The purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the District the question of whether three (3) members shall be elected to the Governing Board of the Keppel Union School District.

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder) will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for and holding of the above-mentioned election. The Keppel Union School District will pay the costs of the election. If any agency holds an election on November 3, 2026, Keppel Union School District shall pay its pro rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes.



Filing of Candidate Statements

Whereas The Governing Board Member elections are scheduled for Election Day in November, and

Whereas Election Code Section 10012 permits a local agency to require payment in advance of each candidate's pro rata share of the printing, handling, and mailing costs of their candidate statement as a condition of having it included in the voter's sample ballot pamphlet, and

Whereas The district also has the option of increasing the word limit for these statements from 200 to 400.

Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Board of Trustees of the Keppel Union School District places a maximum word limitation of 400 on candidate statements with the payment of the estimated cost to be made by the candidate at the time of filing.
