Retroactive Parking Fee Waiver for LA Conservation Corps 40th Anniversary

Reception

The Los Angeles Conservation Corps has been operating for 40 years as a workforce development nonprofit that focuses on outcomes that benefit the environment and communities in the greater Los Angeles region. Over the past 40 years, the Los Angeles Conservation Corps has served 25,000 young adults and teens through their workforce development and 150,000 LAUSD students through the After School Program. In addition, the Los Angeles Conservation Corps and its crews have planted or distributed 400,000 trees, restored 9,000 acres of habitat, recycled 4,000 tons of beverage containers, and removed 30,000,000 square feet of graffiti. Also, the Los Angeles Conservation Corps has developed and sustained a strong expertise in serving Los Angeles communities through both technical work and comprehensive support services for its participants and has been a steadfast partner of the County.

In recognition of the Los Angeles Conservation Corps, the Chair hosted a reception to and presented a scroll during the April 28th Board meeting congratulating, commending, and thanking the Los Angeles Conservation Corps for 40 years of service to the community through workforce development for our young Angelenos and environmental
