**Retroactive Parking Fee Waiver for Interagency of Child Abuse and Neglect
(ICAN) Poster Design Contest Winners Reception**

The Interagency of Child Abuse and Neglect (ICAN) was created in 1977 by the Board of Supervisors to develop and coordinate services for the prevention, identification, and treatment of child abuse and neglect in the County. It is the largest County-based multi-agency child abuse council in the nation, with participants from 32 city, County, state, and federal agencies. ICAN runs 15 task forces and committees, five annual conferences, and has published three annual reports on the State of Child Abuse in LA County, Infant Safe Surrender, and Child Death Review. The ICAN Child Death Review Team was the first in the nation and is now replicated in all states and in 13 foreign countries. In the First District, ICAN partners with Alma Family Services to provide critical child abuse prevention programming.

ICAN hosts a poster art contest each year to raise Child Abuse Prevention awareness for students. The ICAN committee selects 1 grand prize winner, 5 winners, and 19 finalists. Each year, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors partners with the ICAN to host a poster art contest reception, celebrating participants of the contest.
