ORDER BIENNIAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES ELECTION

Order of Election for Rosemead School District of Los Angeles County, California.

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Education Code (EC) Sections 5000-5030, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby ORDERED to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following specifications of the Election Order made under the authority of EC § 5302, § 5304, and § 5322.

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The polling hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on multiple days at the Voting Centers leading up to Election Day.

The purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the district the question of whether three (3) members shall be elected to the Board of Trustees of the Rosemead School District.

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder) will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for and holding of the above-mentioned election. The Rosemead School District will pay the costs of the election. If any agency holds an election on November 3, 2026, the Rosemead School District shall pay its pro rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election and shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Clerk of the district is hereby directed to furnish two (2) copies of this order to the County Superintendent not less than 130 days prior to the date set for the election.

**BOARD OF TRUSTEES' CANDIDATE STATEMENT POLICY, AS IT PERTAINS TO
CALLING AN ELECTION TO FILL THREE (3) VACANCIES**

WHEREAS, a Board of Trustee Member election is scheduled to be held in Rosemead School District on November 3, 2026, and;

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 13307 permits a local agency to require payment in advance of each candidate's pro rata share of the printing, handling, and mailing costs of their candidate statement as a condition of having it included in the voter's sample ballot pamphlet, and;

WHEREAS, a school district has the option of increasing the word limit for the candidate statement from 200 to 400;

WHEREAS, California Elections Code Sections 13307(c)(1)(2) and 13307.7, permitted the County to launch an Online Candidate Statement pilot in Los Angeles County in 2022 that allowed candidates running for County level offices to pay for a candidate statement that would be posted online, but would not be printed in the hard copy sample ballot/voter guide. The County pilot was converted into a program that is now extended to include cities, school districts, and other local jurisdictions. The County will include all online statements that are published on a dedicated page on the www.lavote.gov website;

WHEREAS, The County office is extending the authority to afford candidates the opportunity to elect providing an online candidate statement and/or a statement in print. The authorization by the Board of Trustees to include the online option for candidates is indefinite for all future elections, until retracted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT, the Board of Trustees of the Rosemead School District does hereby resolve, determine, and designate the following:

1. The Rosemead School District determines that payment is required in advance and the County of Los Angeles, Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's Office will estimate the cost and will collect the fee at the time the candidate statement is filed, and;
2. The Rosemead School District designates 200 words as the maximum number of words for any candidate's statement.

3. On June 20, 2024, the Rosemead School District Board of Trustees authorized the option for candidates to provide their candidate statements via the online County platform, and this authorization will continue for future elections until the option is retracted.


