Pacific Palisades Taskforce on Hillside Homelessness Parking Fee Waiver

2026

Founded in 2014 with the support of former California State Assemblymember Richard Bloom and former Los Angeles County Supervisor Sheila Kuehl, the Pacific Palisades Task Force on Homelessness provides dedicated services and support to the local unhoused population. In partnership with The People Concern, the Task Force conducts regular outreach and critical resource coordination in the community. To mitigate high wildfire risks and address public safety concerns, the Task Force also conducts annual safety assessments and outreach in the Pacific Palisades hillsides, an area where individuals have historically established encampments.

On June 10, 2026, 20 volunteers mobilized at the Will Rogers Lifeguard Tower to launch a collaborative hillside outreach effort. Partnering with The People Concern, the group brought together a powerful coalition of volunteers alongside city, county, and state representatives. The joint team canvassed the hillside area to conduct direct community engagement, linking unhoused residents with critical services and long-term support.
