**RESOLUTION NO. 2025/26-38
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE
HACIENDA LA PUENTE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
PROPOSING A LIMITATION ON THE NUMBER OF TERMS
SERVED BY MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD**

WHEREAS, a majority of the Board of Education of the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District ("Board") believes that periodic leadership turnover on the governing board promotes accountability, encourages civic participation, and provides additional community members with the opportunity to serve; and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 35107(c) authorizes the governing board of a school district to adopt a proposal to limit the number of terms a member of the governing board may serve, subject to approval by the voters of the school district; and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 35107(c) further provides that any proposal to limit the number of terms served by a member of a school district governing board shall apply prospectively only and shall not become operative unless submitted to the electors of the school district at a regularly scheduled election and approved by a majority of the votes cast; and

WHEREAS, members of the Board serve four-year terms of office pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to propose a limitation providing that no person may serve more than two (2) lifetime four-year terms as a member of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board intends to adopt a lifetime service limit of two (2) consecutive four-year terms of members of the Governing Board of the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District, and no person may serve more than two (2) full four-year terms on the Board regardless of the trustee area represented. Any full four-year term served on or after December 11, 2026 shall count toward the term limit, consistent with the prospective application required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that submitting this proposal to the voters will allow the electorate of the District to determine whether such term limits should be imposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Education ("Board") hereby determines, finds, and resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. Submission of Term Limits Proposal to Voters. Pursuant to Education Code section 35107(c), the Board hereby orders that a proposal to limit the number of terms a member of the Board may serve be submitted to the electors of the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District at the next regularly scheduled election authorized by law.

Vision Statement:

The Hacienda La Puente Unified School District is a community committed to developing lifelong learners who value themselves and the diversity of all people; apply decision-making skills leading to responsible actions; and use creativity, critical thinking, and problem solving in meeting the challenges of a changing society.

SECTION 3. Proposed Term Limit. If approved by the voters, the proposal shall provide that no person may serve more than two (2) consecutive full four-year terms as a member of the Board, regardless of the trustee area represented. Any full four-year term served on or after December 11, 2026 shall count toward the term limit. The limitation shall apply prospectively only, as required by law.

SECTION 4. Ballot Measure and Ballot Language. The Board hereby directs that the ballot measure submitted to the voters shall be presented in substantially the following form:

BALLOT QUESTION

Shall members of the Board of Education of the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District be limited to serving no more than two (2) consecutive four-year terms during their lifetime regardless of the trustee area represented?

SECTION 5. The Superintendent or designee is authorized and directed to take all actions necessary and appropriate to submit the measure to the voters, including coordination with the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk and the preparation and filing of all required election materials.

SECTION 6. The Board finds that this Resolution and the proposed ballot measure are not a project within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because they relate to organizational or administrative activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

SECTION 7. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the Resolution, which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.

SECTION 8. If approved by the voters, the term limits would be effective on January 1, 2027.


SECTION 9. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025/26-39
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE
HACIENDA LA PUENTE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT REQUESTING
CONSOLIDATION OF A DISTRICT BALLOT MEASURE
WITH THE NOVEMBER 3, 2026 STATEWIDE ELECTION AND
REQUESTING ELECTION SERVICES FROM THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY
REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK**

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District ("Board") has adopted a resolution calling an election for the submission to the qualified electors of the District of a ballot measure proposing a limitation on the number of consecutive terms that may be served by members of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that the District election be consolidated with the statewide election scheduled on November 3, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code, Section 10403(a) requires that when a district requests consolidation of its election with a statewide election, the district shall file with the Board of Supervisors and the County elections official a resolution requesting consolidation, setting forth the exact form of the question to appear on the ballot, and acknowledging that the election will be conducted pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code, Section 10403(a)(3) further requires that the resolution acknowledge that the consolidated election will be held and conducted in the manner prescribed in Elections Code section 10418; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to request that the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk conduct and administer the consolidated election and provide all election-related services required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Education ("Board") hereby determines, finds, and resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Vision Statement:

The Hacienda La Puente Unified School District is a community committed to developing lifelong learners who value themselves and the diversity of all people; apply decision-making skills leading to responsible actions; and use creativity, critical thinking, and problem solving in meeting the challenges of a changing society.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Elections Code, Section 10403, the Board hereby requests that the District's election submitting a ballot measure proposing Board member term limits, as adopted in Resolution No. 2025/26-38, OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE HACIENDA LA PUENTE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPOSING A LIMITATION ON THE NUMBER OF TERMS SERVED BY MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD to be consolidated with the statewide election to be held on the next statewide election on November 3, 2026, and that the consolidated election be held and conducted by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.

SECTION 3. The Board acknowledges that the consolidated election shall be held and conducted in the manner prescribed by Elections Code, Section 10418, as required by Elections Code, Section 10403(a)(3).

SECTION 4. The Board requests that the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk provide all election services necessary for the conduct of the consolidated election, including preparation of ballots, precinct administration, vote tabulation, and certification of results.

SECTION 5. The Board commits to reimbursing the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk for the cost of processing and conducting the election.

SECTION 6. The Superintendent or designee is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors and the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk in accordance with Elections Code, Section 10403.

SECTION 7. The Board finds that this Resolution relates to organizational or administrative activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment and therefore is not a project within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act.

SECTION 8. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
