The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The polling hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on multiple days at the Voting Centers leading up to Election Day.

The purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the district the question of whether 2 members [Trustee area 1 and 2] shall be elected to the Governing Board of the Little Lake City School District.



Advance Payment of School Board Election Expenses


WHEREAS, Elections Code section 13307 permits a local agency to require each candidate to pay in advance his or her pro rata share of the printing, handling, translating and mailing costs of a candidate's statement;

WHEREAS, the payment of such pro rata share of the printing, handling, translating and mailing costs of a candidate's statement is a condition of having it included in the voter's pamphlet; and

WHEREAS, the maximum word limitation for the candidate's statement is 200 words.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the payment of the maximum estimated cost of the filing of candidate statements for the district elections must be paid at the time of filing.
