RESOLUTION NO. 26-21

**A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026, FOR THE ELECTION
OF CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS**

**THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES, DECLARES, DETERMINES, AND ORDERS
AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Elections Code §§ 1301 and 1400, the City Council calls for a general municipal election to be held in the City of Bellflower, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of electing three members of the City Council for: Council Districts 1, 3 and 5 (General Election; full-term/ 4 years).

SECTION 2. The exact form of the question to be voted on at the election for City Council for District Nos. 1, 3 and 5 as it should appear on the ballot is as follows:

“FOR MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL (District 1) – Vote for one (four-year term)”

“FOR MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL (District 3) – Vote for one (four-year term)”

“FOR MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL (District 5) – Vote for one (four-year term)”

SECTION 3. The ballots to be used at the election must be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter, and all supplies, equipment, and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 5. The vote centers for the election will be open at 7:00 a.m. of the day of the election and will remain open continuously from that time until 8:00 p.m. of the same day when the vote centers will be closed, pursuant to Elections Code Section 14212, except as provided in Sections 4005 and 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 6. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the election will be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 7. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form, and manner as required by law.

SECTION 8. If the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors permits the General Municipal Election to be consolidated with the Countywide General Election on November 3, 2026, then, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Sections 5, 6, or 7, above, within the City precincts, voting centers, and election officers of the two elections will be the same; the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles will canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election; and the election will be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

SECTION 10. *Electronic Signatures.* This Resolution may be executed with electronic signatures in accordance with Government Code §16.5. Such electronic signatures will be treated in all respects as having the same effect as an original signature.

SECTION 11. The Mayor, or presiding officer, is hereby authorized to affix his signature to this Resolution signifying its adoption by the City Council of the City of Bellflower, and the City Clerk, or her duly appointed deputy, is directed to attest thereto.


SECTION 12. This Resolution will become effective immediately upon adoption.







RESOLUTION NO. 26-22

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO CONSOLIDATE THE CITY OF BELLFLOWER'S GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026, WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE DATE PURSUANT TO ELECTIONS CODE § 10403

THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES, DECLARES, DETERMINES, AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the requirements of Elections Code § 10002, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is requested to consent and agree to conduct specified election services for the consolidation of the City of Bellflower's General Municipal Election with a Countywide General Election that will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of electing three members of the City Council for: Districts 1, 3 and 5 (General Election; full-term/4 years); and that the County of Los Angeles take all necessary steps to hold a consolidated election.

SECTION 2. The City Council requests the Board of Supervisors to direct the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to administer, manage, and oversee all facets of the City of Bellflower's November 3, 2026, General Municipal Election and further direct the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to perform all necessary function, services, and tasks related to the complete and successful conduct of the election; the provision of all election materials and equipment; the hiring, training, and supervision of vote center workers and other election personnel; the printing and distribution of ballot materials; the translation of ballot materials; the collection of submitted ballots; the tallying of votes; canvassing and certification of election results. The County election department is authorized to canvass the returns of the general municipal election. The election will be held in all respects as if there were only one election and only one form of ballot will be used. The election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the Countywide Election.

SECTION 3. The City of Bellflower recognizes that all necessary expenses incurred by the County in performing these services will be paid by the City of Bellflower.

SECTION 4. The County's services will not include the final declaration of the results by the City Council pursuant to Elections Code §§ 10262 through 10265.

SECTION 5. The candidate filing process will be conducted by the City Clerk with the support of the County Registrar between the dates of July 13 and August 7, 2026 (or August 12, 2026, if an incumbent does not file), pursuant to Elections Code §§ 10220 through 10230. Any person seeking to file nomination documents on the last day should contact the City Clerk's Office in advance.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the County election department of the County of Los Angeles.

SECTION 7. This Resolution does not affect any penalty, forfeiture, or liability incurred before, or preclude prosecution and imposition of penalties for any violation occurring before, this Resolution's effective date. Any such amended part will remain in full force and effect for sustaining action or prosecuting violations occurring before the effective date of this Resolution.

SECTION 8. If any part of this Resolution or its application is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the City Council intends that such invalidity will not affect the effectiveness of the remaining provisions or applications and, to this end, the provisions of this Resolution are severable.

SECTION 9. To the extent that any other resolution pertaining to the request to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles to direct the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to administer, manage, and oversee the City of Bellflower's General Municipal Election to held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, and request for consolidation with any countywide election to be held on November 3, 2026, is incorporated into this Resolution, it is superseded in its entirety. In all other particulars not specifically provided in this Resolution, the Election will be held and conducted as provided by law.

SECTION 10. *Electronic Signatures.* This Resolution may be executed with electronic signatures in accordance with Government Code §16.5. Such electronic signatures will be treated in all respects as having the same effect as an original signature.

SECTION 11. The Mayor, or presiding officer, is hereby authorized to affix his signature to this Resolution signifying its adoption by the City Council of the City of Bellflower, and the City Clerk, or her duly appointed deputy, is directed to attest thereto.


SECTION 12. This Resolution will become effective immediately upon adoption.


