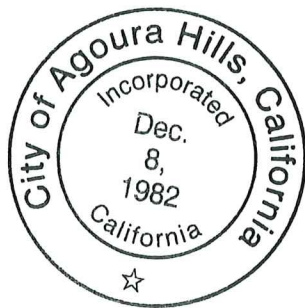

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-2135**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026, FOR THE ELECTION OF THREE (3) MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on November 3, 2026, for the election of Municipal Officers; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Agoura Hills, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing three (3) Members of the City Council for the full term of four (4) years.

**SECTION 2:** That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in the form and content as required by law.

**SECTION 3:** That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to coordinate with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (County) to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election. That the word limitation for a candidate's statement is 200 words and advance payment to the City of Agoura Hills is due at the time the prospective candidate files their nomination papers with the City Clerk.

**SECTION 4:** That vote centers for the election shall be open as required during the identified voting period pursuant to Elections Code Section 10242, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

**SECTION 5:** That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

**SECTION 6:** That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given, and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional notice of the election in time, form, and manner as required by law.

**SECTION 7:** That in the event of a tie vote (if any two or more persons receive an equal and the highest number of votes for an office) as certified by the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, the City Council, in accordance with Elections Code Section 15651(a), shall set a date and time and place and summon the candidates who have received the tie votes to appear and will determine the tie by lot.

**SECTION 8:** That the City Council authorizes the City Clerk to administer said election and all reasonable and actual election expenses incurred shall be paid to the County of Los Angeles by the City of Agoura Hills when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.

**SECTION 9:** That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

**SECTION 10:** That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution forthwith with the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, Election Coordination Unit, of the County of Los Angeles.

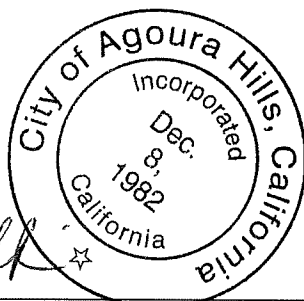

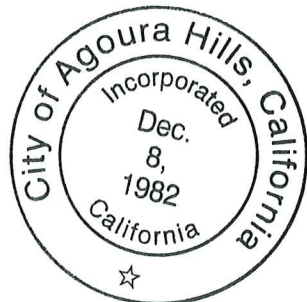

## RESOLUTION NO. 26-2136

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE PERTAINING TO CANDIDATES' STATEMENTS SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026

**WHEREAS**, Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of any local agency adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for a municipal election, including costs of the candidate's statement:

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

#### **SECTION 1: GENERAL PROVISIONS.**

That pursuant to Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California, each candidate for elective office to be voted for at an Election to be held in the City of Agoura Hills on November 3, 2026, may prepare a candidate's statement on an appropriate form provided by the City Clerk. The statement may include the name, age, and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate himself or herself. The statement shall not include party affiliation of the candidate, nor membership or activity in partisan political organizations. Pursuant to Section 13308 of the Elections Code, the candidate's statement shall make no reference to other candidates for that office or to another candidate's qualifications, character, or activities. The statement shall be filed in typewritten form in the office of the City Clerk at the time the candidate's nomination papers are filed. Except as provided in Section 13309 of the Elections Code. The statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the period for filing nomination papers and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

#### **SECTION 2: FOREIGN LANGUAGE POLICY.**

- A. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, the City is not required at this time to translate candidate statements into additional languages.
- B. The County will print and mail voter information guides and candidates' statements to all registered voters in English. The County will make the voter information guides and candidates' statements in the required languages available at all polling places, on the County's website, and in the Election Official's office. If the candidate submits a candidate's statement for the

sample ballot, the County can include a Spanish translation of the candidate's statement, if the candidate requests this and agrees to pay for the printing.

**SECTION 3: PAYMENT.**

The County shall estimate the total cost of printing, handling, translating, mailing, and posting the candidates' statements filed pursuant to this section, including costs incurred as a result of complying with the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, and require each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance to the local agency his or her estimated pro rata share as a condition of having his or her statement included in the Official Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet. In the event the estimated payment is required, the estimate is just an approximation of the actual cost that varies from one election to another election and may be significantly more or less than the estimate, depending on the actual number of candidates filing statements. Accordingly, the City Clerk is not bound by the estimate and may, on a pro rata basis, bill the candidate for additional actual expense or refund any excess paid depending on the final actual cost. In the event of underpayment, the City Clerk may require the candidate to pay the balance of the cost incurred. In the event of overpayment, the City Clerk shall prorate the excess amount among the candidates and refund the excess amount paid within thirty (30) days of the election.

- A. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidate statement in the Official Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet.
- B. The deposit required for the candidate statement for the November 3, 2026, General Municipal Election in Agoura Hills is Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$500.00) that is due at the time the prospective candidate files their nomination papers (and candidate statement) with the City Clerk.
- C. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of translating the candidate statement into Spanish pursuant to Federal and/or State law.

**SECTION 4: ADDITIONAL MATERIALS.**

No candidate will be permitted to include additional materials in the sample ballot package.

**SECTION 5:** That the City Clerk shall provide each candidate or the candidate's representative a copy of this Resolution at the time the nominating petitions are issued.

**SECTION 6:** That all previous Resolutions establishing City Council policy on payment for the candidate's statements are repealed.


**SECTION 7:** That this Resolution shall apply only to the election to be held on November 3, 2026, and shall then be repealed.

**SECTION 8:** That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

**SECTION 9.** That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution forthwith with the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, Election Coordination Unit, of the County of Los Angeles.

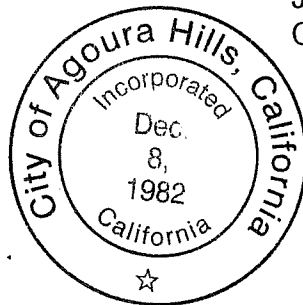

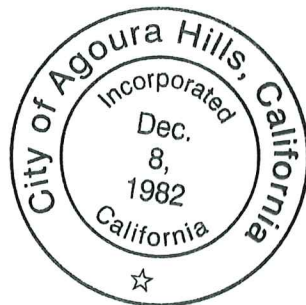

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SAID DATE AND TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS PURSUANT TO SECTION 10403 OF THE CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, there has been called and ordered a General Municipal Election to be held in the City of Agoura Hills, California ("the City") on November 3, 2026, for the election of three (3) Members of the City Council for the full term of four (4) years (a copy of Resolution No. 26-2135 calling said election is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference).

**WHEREAS**, the County of Los Angeles will conduct a General Election on the same day in territory that is in part the same; and

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City the precincts, vote centers, and election officers of the two elections be the same, that the County of Los Angeles canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election, and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AGOURA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of the election of three (3) Members of the City Council..

**SECTION 2.** That the County of Los Angeles is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used. The election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the law regulating the general election.

**SECTION 3.** That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

**SECTION 4.** That the City of Agoura Hills recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any such costs upon presentation of a reasonably detailed invoice.


**SECTION 5.** That in all particulars not otherwise specifically provided in this Resolution, the Election shall be held and conducted as provided by law.

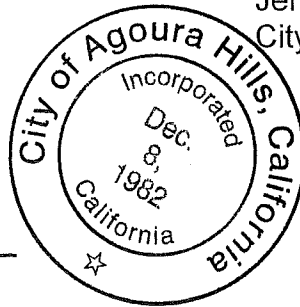
