RESOLUTION NO. 2026-006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN PARK, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on November 3, 2026, for the election of Municipal Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN PARK, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Baldwin Park, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, a General Municipal Election of the qualified electors of the City for the purpose of electing two (2) Members of the City Council, City Clerk and City Treasurer each for the full term of four years.

Section 2. The City Clerk or the City Elections Official, is authorized, instructed and directed to coordinate with the County of Los Angeles Registrar of Voters to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

Section 3. The polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, pursuant to Election Code Section 10242, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California. In addition, ballot drop boxes and vote centers for the election shall be open as required during the identified voting period pursuant to Elections Code Sections 4007 and 14401.

Section 4. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

Section 5. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk or the City Elections Official, is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

Section 6. In the event of a tie vote (if any two or more persons receive an equal and the highest number of votes for an office) as certified by the Los Angeles County Registrar of Voters, the City Council in accordance with Election Code Section 15651(a), shall set a date and time and place and summon the candidates who have received the tie votes to appear and will determine the tie by lot. "By Lot" means, by deciding the matter

through implementing a method of chance, in order to afford each candidate receiving tie votes a fair opportunity at election.

Section 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions and transmit copies of the necessary resolutions to the County Registrar forthwith.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-007

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN PARK, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO ORDER THE CONSOLIDATION OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026 WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES THE SAME DAY AND AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO CANVASS THE RETURNS OF SAID GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION; AND REQUEST THAT THE REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK OF SAID COUNTY BE PERMITTED TO RENDER ELECTION SERVICES TO THE CITY OF BALDWIN PARK RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF SAID GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE SECTION 10403

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election has been called by the City of Baldwin Park to be held in the City of Baldwin Park on November 3, 2026; and

WHEREAS, a statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles has been or will be called to be held on November 3, 2026, and

WHEREAS, it is desired, pursuant to the authority found in California Elections Code Section 10403, to consolidate said General Municipal Election with said Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN PARK HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby respectfully requested to order the consolidation of said General Municipal Election to be held on November 3, 2026, with the Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles on November 3, 2026.

Section 2. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby further respectfully requested to place upon the same ballot as that provided for said Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles on November 3, 2026, the names of the candidates for the office of:

Two (2) Members of the City Council - Full Term
One (1) City Clerk - Full Term
One (1) City Treasurer - Full Term

To be submitted to the electors of the City of Baldwin Park at said General Municipal Election.

Section 3. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby authorized and respectfully requested to canvass the returns of said General Municipal Election.

Section 4. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby authorized and respectfully requested to authorize and permit the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles to:

- a) Print and supply ballots for said City of Baldwin Park General Municipal Election; and
- b) Mail the City's sample ballots and candidate statements of qualifications to the electors of the City of Baldwin Park as part of the same material that will be mailed to the voters of the Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles; and
- c) Perform such other services as may be required for the consolidation and conduct of said City of Baldwin Park General Municipal Election with said Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles.

Section 5. The vote centers for the election shall be open as required during the identified voting period pursuant to California Elections Code sections 4007 and 14401.

Section 6. The City shall reimburse the County of Los Angeles in full for the services performed on behalf of the City upon the presentation of a bill by the County.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles and to transmit an electronic copy to the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles.

Section 8. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its approval.

Section 9. The City Clerk shall certify as to the adoption of this City Council Resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN PARK, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE PERTAINING TO CANDIDATE STATEMENTS SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026.

WHEREAS, §13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of any local agency adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for a municipal election, including costs of the candidates statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN PARK, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. General Provisions. Pursuant to Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California, each candidate for elective office to be voted for at an Election to be held in the City of Baldwin Park on November 3, 2026 may prepare a candidate's statement on an appropriate form provided by the Election Official or his/her designee. The statement may include the name, age and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate himself or herself. The statement shall not include party affiliation of the candidate, nor membership or activity in partisan political organizations. In addition to these restrictions, pursuant to Elections Code Section 13308, any candidate statement submitted shall be limited to a recitation of the candidate's own personal background and qualifications and shall not in any way make reference to other candidates for that office or to another candidate's qualifications, character, or activities. The City Elections Official shall not cause to be printed, posted on an Internet Web site, or circulated any statement that the City Elections Official determines is not so limited or that includes any reference prohibited by this section. The statement shall be filed in typewritten form in the office of the City Clerk at the time the candidate's nomination papers are filed. The statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the period for filing nomination papers and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 13307(c) of the California Elections Code, the governing body of the City of Baldwin Park authorizes the preparation of candidate statements for nonpartisan elective office for the purpose of electronic distribution. Candidates will prepare statements for electronic distribution pursuant to Section 13307(a) of the Elections Code. A statement prepared pursuant to this subdivision shall be posted on the internet website of the County Elections Official. Pursuant to Section 13307.7(a) of the Elections Code, candidates shall provide payment of the requisite fee to cover the duties and procedures set forth in Sections 13307(b) and (d) of the Elections Code.

Section 3. Language Translation Policy

A. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, candidates' statements will be translated into all languages required by the County of Los Angeles. The County is required to translate candidate's statements into the following languages: Spanish.

B. The County will mail separate voter information guides and candidates' statements in other languages, as required, to voters pursuant to County policies and procedures. The County will make the voter information guides and candidates' statements in the required languages available at all polling places and voting centers, on the County's website, and in the Election Official's office.

Section 4. Payment.

A. Translations:

1. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of translating the candidates statement into any required foreign language as specified in A of Section 3 above pursuant to Federal and/or State law.

2. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of translating the candidates statement into any foreign language that is not required as specified in (A) and/or B of Section 3 above, pursuant to Federal and/or State law, but is requested as an option by the candidate.

B. Printing:

1. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidates statement in English in the main voter pamphlet.

2. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidates statement in a foreign language required in (A) of Section 3 above, in the main voter pamphlet.

3. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidates statement in a foreign language requested by the candidate per (B) of Section 3 above, in the main voter pamphlet.

The Los Angeles County Registrar of Voters shall provide the City Elections Official as determined by the City Council, with an estimate of the total cost of printing, handling, translating, and mailing the candidate's statements filed pursuant to this section, including costs incurred as a result of complying with the Voting Rights Act of 1965 (as amended), and require each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance to the local agency his or her estimated pro rata share as a condition of having his or her statement included in the voter's pamphlet. The estimate is just an approximation of the actual cost that varies from one election to another election and may be significantly more or less than the estimate,

depending on the actual number of candidates filing statements. Accordingly, the City Elections Official is not bound by the estimate and may, on a pro rata basis, bill the candidate for additional actual expense or refund any excess paid depending on the final actual cost. In the event of underpayment, the City Elections Official may require the candidate to pay the balance of the cost incurred. In the event of overpayment, the City Elections Official shall prorate the excess amount among the candidates and refund the excess amount paid within 30 days of the election.

Section 5. Additional Materials. No candidate will be permitted to include additional materials in the voter information guide.

Section 6. The City Elections Official shall provide each candidate or the candidate's representative a copy of this Resolution at the time nominating petitions are issued.

Section 7. All previous resolutions establishing City Council policy on payment for candidates statements are repealed.

Section 8. This resolution shall apply only to the general election to be held on November 3, 2026 and shall then be repealed.

Section 9. The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

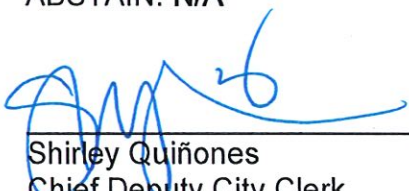
