Order of Election of Long Beach Community College District of Los Angeles County, California

RESOLUTION ORDERING GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTION

RESOLVED that pursuant to Education Code (EC) §§5000-5030, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby ORDERED to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following specifications of the Election Order made under the authority of EC §5302, §5304, and §5322.

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The polling hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on multiple days at the Voting Centers leading up to Election Day.

The purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the district the question of whether three (3) members (Trustee Areas 1, 3, 5) shall be elected to the Governing Board of the Long Beach Community College District.

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder) will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for and holding of the above-mentioned election. The District will pay the costs of the election. If any agency holds an election on November 3, 2026, the Long Beach Community College District shall pay its pro rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election and shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes.

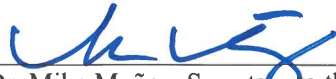
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the District is hereby directed to furnish two copies of this order to the County Superintendent not less than 130 days prior to the date set for the election.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE LONG BEACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT
REGARDING CANDIDATES' STATEMENTS FOR THE
NOVEMBER 3, 2026 GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTION**

WHEREAS, Section 13307 of the California Elections Code, provides that each candidate for nonpartisan elective office in any local agency may prepare a statement describing name, age, occupation, education, and qualifications for consideration by the electorate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of such local agency may limit said statement to 200 words or authorize an increase to 400 words; and

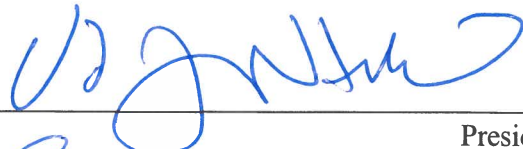
WHEREAS, the local agency may bill each candidate availing himself or herself of these services for prorated costs of printing, handling and translating the statement, if any, incurred by the agency as a result of providing this service.

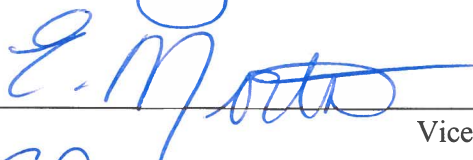
NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the Long Beach Community College District hereby resolve, determine and order as follows:

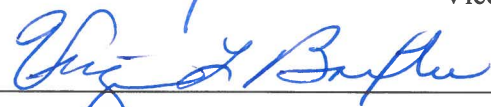
1. That the Candidate's Statement of qualifications be limited to 200 words.
2. That any appropriated costs incurred by the Long Beach Community College District for such handling shall be prorated among the candidates availing themselves of this service.
3. That each candidate requesting to have their Candidate's Statement printed and mailed to the voters, shall be required to pay in advance their estimated prorated cost at the time of filing with the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk office.
4. In compliance with California Law, only English and Spanish candidate statements are included in the ballot booklet. Requests for additional languages will incur additional fees payable in advance by the candidate.
5. Candidates will be billed or refunded, as necessary, when actual costs are received from the election printer.
