RESOLUTION 2880

Order of Election for the Pasadena Unified School District of Los Angeles County, California.

ORDERING GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTION

RESOLVED that pursuant to Education Code (EC) §§5000-5030, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby ORDERED to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following specifications of the Election Code made under the authority of EC §5302, §5304, and §5322.

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The polling hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on multiple days at the Voting Centers leading up to Election Day.

The purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the district the questions of whether four (4) members shall be elected to the Governing Board of the Pasadena Unified School District.

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder) will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for and holding of the above-mentioned election. The Pasadena Unified School District will pay the costs of the election. If any agency holds an election on November 3, 2026, the Pasadena Unified School District shall pay its pro rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election and shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the district is hereby directed to furnish two copies of this order to the county Superintendent not less than 130 days prior to the date set for the election.

The foregoing Resolution and Order was adopted and affirmed by the Governing Board of the Pasadena Unified School District of Los Angeles County, being the Board authorized by law to make the designations contained therein, by formal vote as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2883

A RESOLUTION OF THE PASADENA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE FOR THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION IN GEOGRAPHIC SUB-DISTRICTS 1, 3, 5, AND 7, AND CONSOLIDATING SAID ELECTION WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THAT SAME DATE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Pasadena Unified School District, Board of Education as follows:

SECTION 1. Date of the Pasadena Unified School District General Election. In accordance with the Pasadena City Charter, Section 703, a General Election in the Pasadena Unified School District is hereby called for the purpose of electing Members of the Board of Education in Geographic Sub-Districts 1, 3, 5, and 7 as said sub-districts have heretofore been established, each for the full term of four years. Said election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026.

SECTION 2. Candidates in the General Election. Pursuant to City Charter Section 703, "Candidates to be voted on at the general election shall be residents and qualified voters of the geographic sub-district in which the election is being held. Only voters who live in the geographic sub-district shall be eligible to vote in the elections for Board Member from that geographic sub-district." Pursuant to City Charter Section 706, "The candidate receiving the highest number of votes in the general election for each geographic sub-district shall be deemed elected for that office, without any run-off election."

SECTION 3. Consolidation of Pasadena Unified School District General Election with Statewide General Election. Pursuant to the requirements of California Education

Code Sections 5000 – 5030,” to “Code Sections 5304 (governing board orders election), 5325 (County Superintendent of Schools calls election), and Elections Code Section 10403 (consolidation procedures), and Resolution 2880 of the Pasadena Unified School District Board of Education (Exhibit A), the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby ordered to call the Pasadena Unified School District’s General Election. The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of electing Members of the Board of Education in Geographic Sub-Districts 1, 3, 5, and 7. The County Superintendent shall direct the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to perform all duties and necessary functions incident to the preparation for and holding of the general election.

SECTION 4. Nomination Period. The nomination period for the Pasadena Unified School District’s November 3, 2026 General Election for Board of Education Geographic Sub-Districts 1, 3, 5, and 7 will open on Monday, July 13, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., and will close on Friday, August 7, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. The nomination period is extended to Wednesday, August 12, 2026, at 5:00 p.m., only for those sub-district races where the incumbent Board Member does not file nomination papers.

Any person desiring to become a candidate for the Board of Education to be filled at such election shall file, or have filed, with the City Clerk, acting in the capacity of Assistant Secretary to the Board of Education during Board of Education elections, in the form and in the period prior to the general election prescribed by the California Elections Code, nominating papers signed by him/her specifying for which geographic sub-district he/she is a candidate, signed by not less than twenty five (25) qualified

voters from the geographic sub-district in which the election is held, requesting such candidacy, and accompanied by a filing fee of \$25.00. The names of voters not residents of the geographic sub-district for which the candidate is being nominated shall not be counted by the County Registrar of Voters in determining the sufficiency of such petition.

SECTION 5. Appointment In Lieu of Election Due to Insufficiency of Candidates.

Pursuant to Education Code Sections 5326 and 5328, the Pasadena Unified School District, Board of Education shall, in instances where in a geographic sub-district race following the 83rd day prior to the election and marking the end of the nomination process described in Section 4 of this resolution, where only one person has been nominated for any elective office to be filled at November 3, 2026 General Election, or no one has been nominated for the office, and a petition signed by 50 voters in the geographic sub-district requesting that the Pasadena Unified School District election be held for the offices has not been presented to the officer conducting the election prior to the close of the nomination period, appointment will be made.

Pursuant to Education Code 5328, where a geographic sub-district race of the Pasadena Unified School District is not held, the qualified person nominated shall be seated at the organizational meeting of the board, or if no person has been nominated, the Pasadena Unified School District Board of Education shall appoint a qualified person at a meeting prior to November 3, 2026, and such appointee shall be seated at the organizational meeting of the Board as if elected at a geographic sub-district election.

SECTION 6. Ballots. The ballots to be used for each election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 7. Polling Hours and Vote Centers. The polling hours shall be 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. The Vote Centers for the consolidated elections shall be open as required during the identified voting period, pursuant to Election Code Sections 4007 and 14404.

SECTION 8. Canvass of Election. The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is authorized to canvass and certify the election returns. Pursuant to Pasadena City Charter Section 707, on the fifth Monday following the statewide general election, and at their usual time and place of meeting, the Board of Education shall meet to approve the canvass of returns submitted by the City Clerk acting in his/her capacity as Assistant Secretary to the Board of Education and shall declare the results.

SECTION 9. Particulars. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, said elections shall be noticed and held and all publications made as provided by law for holding school district elections.

SECTION 10. Payment of Election Expenses. That the Pasadena Unified School District recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of these consolidated elections and agrees to reimburse the County for election related costs resulting from said consolidations. The Pasadena Unified School District shall pay to the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk a sum equal to

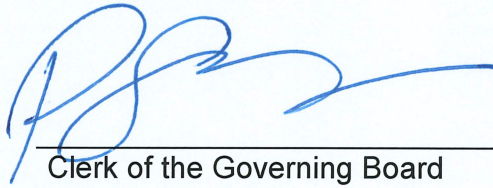
those costs upon the completion of the services and upon presentation to the Pasadena Unified School District of a bill.

SECTION 11. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this resolution with the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools and the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.

SECTION 12. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is given, and the City Clerk acting in the capacity of the Assistant Secretary to the Board of Education is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

RESOLUTION NO. 2885

A RESOLUTION OF THE PASADENA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT SETTING FORTH REGULATIONS RELATING TO CANDIDATE STATEMENTS FOR THE NOVEMBER 3, 2026 GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, Section 13307 of the California Elections Code ("Elections Code") provides that each candidate for nonpartisan elective office in any local agency may prepare a candidate's statement on an appropriate form provided by the City Clerk acting as the Assistant Secretary to the Board of Education. Such statement may include the name, age, and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate himself or herself, except that the statement shall not include the party affiliation of the candidate, nor membership or activity in partisan political organizations. The statement of each candidate shall be filed in typewritten form in the office of the City Clerk acting as the Assistant Secretary to the Board of Education at the same time the candidate's nomination papers are filed. As provided in Section 13307(a)(3), except as provided in Elections Code Section 13309, such statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the period for filing nomination papers and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 13307 also permits the School District to adopt regulations to ensure recovery of the pro-rata costs from each candidate; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 13311 mandates that candidate statements shall remain confidential until the expiration of the filing deadline.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Pasadena Unified School District, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Clerk, acting in the capacity of Assistant Secretary to the Board of Education, shall advise all persons to whom nominating papers are issued of the provisions of the Elections Code pertaining to said candidate's statement and the requirements thereunder.

SECTION 2. A statement must be filed by the candidate at the same time the candidate's nominating papers are filed.

SECTION 3. No candidate will be permitted to include additional statements or materials in the sample ballot pamphlet.

SECTION 4. A deposit of not less than \$600.00 shall be required for each candidate, for Member of the Board of Education in geographic sub-districts 1, 3, 5, and 7, requesting publication of a candidate's statement pursuant to the Elections Code. The deposit is due at the time the nominating papers and candidate's statement are filed.

Candidates who wish to include Spanish translations of their candidate statements in the English booklet shall pay printing costs to include the translated statement. Candidates will pay the estimated costs at the time nomination papers and the candidate's statement are filed, with the estimated costs being equal to the amount required for the printing of the English statement.

Candidates may also choose to post their candidate statement on the Los Angeles County's webpage as an alternative to printing in the voter information pamphlet. This alternative is provided at a reduced cost, with the candidate selecting this option at the time of filing nomination and candidate statement information with the City Clerk's Office.

SECTION 5. Each candidate filing a candidate statement shall be liable for a pro-rata share of the actual cost of printing the candidate's statement in English, or English and Spanish in the English only booklet. No candidate will be charged a pro-rata share of costs incurred as a result of complying with the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965. The Pasadena Unified School District shall bill each candidate for the actual pro-rated costs of printing the candidate's statement, if required, and such bill shall be due and payable immediately upon receipt thereof. If the actual cost is less than the deposit, the Pasadena Unified School District shall refund any excess deposit to the candidate within 30 days of receiving the invoice for candidate statement costs from the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.

SECTION 6. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, candidate statements will be translated into all languages required by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk. It is the County's policy to print single-language ballot books, with voters receiving election information in the requested language. For voters in Pasadena that have self-designated as English proficient, they will receive an English only booklet. For Spanish, Chinese, and other languages required under the Federal Voting Rights Act for voters that have requested election information in those languages, they will receive single-language ballot books both in English and the requested language.

SECTION 7. All translations shall be provided by professionally-certified translators. The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk shall allow: bold type, italics, underlining, capitalization, indentations, and leading hyphens. The City Clerk acting as the Assistant Secretary to the Board of Education, in consultation with the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, shall comply with all recommendations and standards set forth by the California Secretary of State regarding occupational designations and other matters relating to elections.

SECTION 8. The City Clerk, acting in the capacity of Assistant Secretary to the Board of Education, shall provide each candidate, or the candidate's representative, a copy of this resolution at the time nomination forms are issued.

SECTION 9. All previous resolutions establishing candidate statement policies regarding payment and/or format are no longer in force or effect.

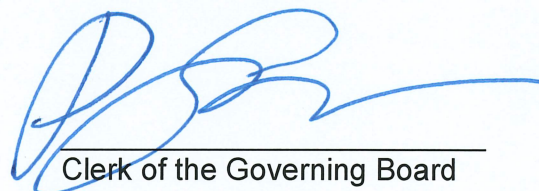
