RESOLUTION ORDERING GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Education Code (EC) Sections 5000-5030, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby ORDERED to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following specifications of the Election Order made under the authority of EC Sections 5302, 5304, and 5322.

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The polling hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.

The purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the District the question of whether one member (Trustee Area 2) shall be elected to the Governing Board of the Compton Community College District for the remainder of the unexpired term (two years until December 2028).

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder) will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for and holding of the above-mentioned election. The candidate will be responsible for the cost associated with filing their candidate statement (400 words allowed). The Compton Community College District will pay the costs of the election. If any agency holds an election on November 3, 2026, the Compton Community College District shall pay its pro rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election and shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary to the Governing Board of the District is hereby directed to furnish two copies of this order to the County Superintendent not less than 130 days prior to the date set for the election.
