RESOLUTION NO. 2633

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING HILLS ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO ORDER THE CONSOLIDATION OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026 WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES THE SAME DAY; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO CANVASS THE RETURNS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION; AND TO REQUEST THAT THE REGISTRAR-RECORDER/COUNTY CLERK OF THE COUNTY BE PERMITTED TO RENDER FULL SERVICES TO THE CITY OF ROLLING HILLS ESTATES, RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE SECTION 10403

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING HILLS ESTATES RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The City Council finds as follows:

A. A General Municipal Election has been called by the City of Rolling Hills Estates, to be held in the City of Rolling Hills Estates on November 3, 2026.

B. A Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles has been or will be called to be held on November 3, 2026.

C. The City Council desires, pursuant to Elections Code section 10403, to consolidate the General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles.

SECTION 2. Request for Consolidation. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby respectfully requested to order the consolidation of the City's General Municipal Election to be held on November 3, 2026, with the Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles on November 3, 2026.

SECTION 3. Councilmember Candidates to be Placed on the Ballot. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is further respectfully requested to place upon the same ballot as that provided for the Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles on November 3, 2026, the names of the candidates for the offices of:

Councilmember, Full Term of four years
Councilmember, Full Term of four years

to be submitted to the electors of the City of Rolling Hills Estates, at the General Municipal Election.

SECTION 4. Conduct of Election. The City of Rolling Hills Estates acknowledges that the consolidated election will be held and conducted in the manner prescribed in Elections Code section 10418.

SECTION 5. Provision of Registrar-Recorder Services. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby authorized and respectfully requested to authorize and permit the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles to:

- a) Print and supply ballots for the City of Rolling Hills Estates' General Municipal Election.
- b) Mail the City's sample ballots and candidate statements of qualifications to the electors of the City of Rolling Hills Estates as part of the same material that will be mailed to the voters of the Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles.

- c) Canvass the returns of the City's General Municipal Election.
- d) Perform such other services as may be required for the consolidation and conduct of the City of Rolling Hills Estates General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election to be held in the County of Los Angeles.

SECTION 7. Vote Centers. The vote centers for the election will be open as required during the identified voting period pursuant to Elections Code sections 4007 and 14401.

SECTION 8. Reimbursement. The City will reimburse the County of Los Angeles in full for the services performed on behalf of the City upon the presentation of a bill by the County.

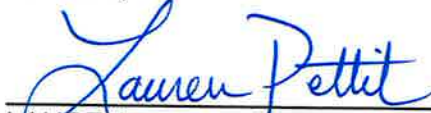
SECTION 9. Tie Vote. In the event of a tie vote (if any two or more persons receive an equal and the highest number of votes for an office) as certified by the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, the City Council, in accordance with Election Code section 15651(a), will set a date and time and place and summon the candidates who have received the tie votes to appear and will determine the tie by lot.

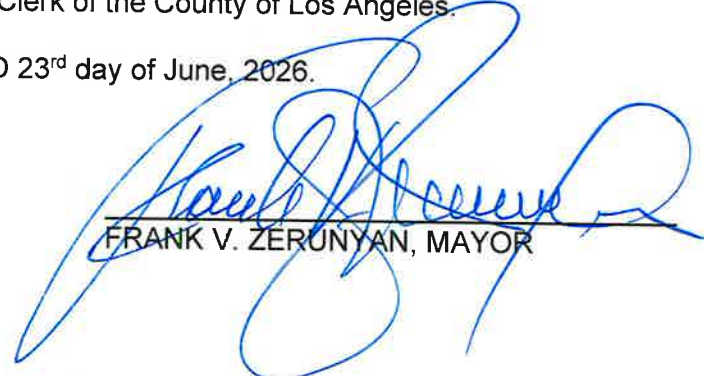
SECTION 10. Other State Law Election Provisions. With respect to all particulars of the election not recited in this resolution, the election will be held and conducted as provided by State law for holding consolidated municipal elections.

SECTION 10. Certification. The City Clerk is hereby directed to certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions, deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles and to transmit an electronic copy to the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles.

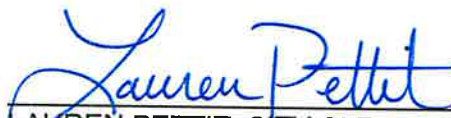

CITY OF ROLLING HILLS ESTATES**LOS ANGELES COUNTY, CALIFORNIA****RESOLUTION NO. 2634****A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING HILLS ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE PERTAINING TO CANDIDATE STATEMENTS SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026****THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING HILLS ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY. Elections Code section 13307 provides that the governing body of any local agency may adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for a municipal election, including costs of the candidates statement;

SECTION 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS. Pursuant to Elections Code section 13307, each candidate for elective office to be voted for at the November 3, 2026 election, to be held in the City of Rolling Hills Estates, may prepare a candidate statement on an appropriate form provided by the City Clerk. The statement may include the name, age and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate himself or herself. The statement may not include any party affiliation of the candidate, nor membership or activity in partisan political organizations. The statement must be filed in the office of the City Clerk at the time the candidate's nomination papers are filed. The statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the period for filing nomination papers and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

SECTION 3. FOREIGN LANGUAGE POLICY.

A. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, candidate statements will be translated into all languages required by the County of Los Angeles. The County is required to translate candidate statements into the following languages: Armenian, Chinese, Farsi, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, Vietnamese, and other languages as required.

B. The County will mail separate voter information guides and candidate statements in Armenian, Chinese, Farsi, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, Vietnamese, and other identified languages to only those voters who are on the county voter file as having requested a voter information guide in a particular language. The County will make the voter information guides and candidate statements in the required languages available at all vote centers, on the County's website, and in the Election Official's office.

SECTION 4. PAYMENT.

A. Translations:

1. The candidate must pay for the cost of translating the candidate's statement into any required foreign language as specified in Section 3 (A) and (B) above, pursuant to Federal and State law.

2. The candidate must pay for the cost of translating the candidates statement into any foreign language that is not required as specified in Section 3 (A) and (B) above, pursuant to Federal and State law, but is requested as an option by the candidate.

B. Printing:

1. The candidate must pay for the cost of printing the candidate's statement in English in the main voter pamphlet.

2. The candidate must pay for the cost of printing the candidate's statement in Spanish in the main voter pamphlet.

The City Clerk will estimate the total cost of printing, handling, translating, and mailing the candidate statements filed pursuant to this section, including costs incurred as a result of complying with the Voting Rights Act of 1965 (as amended), and require each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance to the City the candidate's estimated pro rata share as a condition of having the candidate's statement included in the voter information guide. In the event the estimated payment is required, the estimate is just an approximation of the actual cost that varies from one election to another election and may be significantly

more or less than the estimate, depending on the actual number of candidates filing statements. Accordingly, the Clerk is not bound by the estimate and may, on a pro rata basis, bill the candidate for additional actual expense or refund any excess paid depending on the final actual cost. In the event of underpayment, the Clerk may require the candidate to pay the balance of the cost incurred. In the event of overpayment, the Clerk will prorate the excess amount among the candidates and refund the excess amount paid within 30 days of the election.

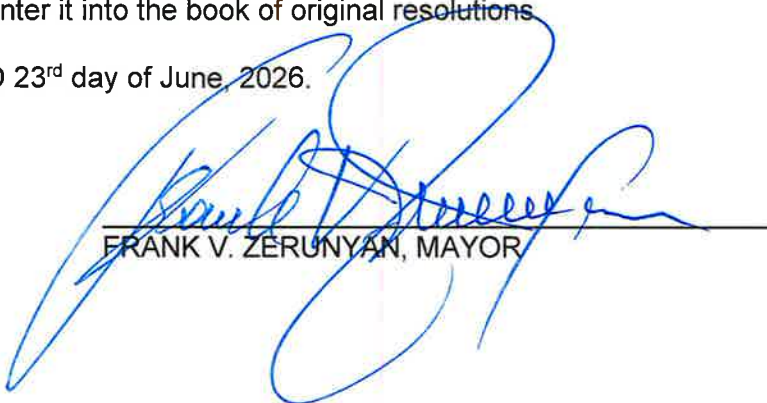
SECTION 5. ADDITIONAL MATERIALS. No candidate will be permitted to include additional materials in the voter information guide.

SECTION 6. COPY OF RESOLUTION. The City Clerk will provide each candidate or the candidate's representative a copy of this resolution at the time nominating petitions are issued.

SECTION 7. EFFECT OF RESOLUTIONS. All previous resolutions establishing City Council policy on payment for candidate statements are repealed. Further, this resolution applies only to the election to be held on November 3, 2026 and will be deemed automatically repealed after the conclusion of the election.

SECTION 8. CITY CLERK CERTIFICATION. The City Clerk is directed to certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
