RESOLUTION NO. 6471

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF MAYWOOD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on November 3, 2026, for the election of Municipal Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the laws of the State of California relating to general law cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Maywood, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, a General Municipal Election of the qualified electors of the City for the purpose of electing three (3) Members of the City Council, elected at-large, each for a full term of four years. No City ballot measure is submitted by this Resolution

Section 2. The City Clerk, Deputy City Clerk, or the City Elections Official as determined by the City Council, is authorized, instructed and directed to coordinate with the County of Los Angeles Registrar of Voters to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

Section 3. The polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10242, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California. In addition, ballot drop boxes and vote centers for the election shall be open as required during the identified voting period pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 4005 and 14401.

Section 4. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

Section 5. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the Deputy City Clerk or the City Elections Official as determined by the City Council, is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

Section 6. The City of Maywood acknowledges that costs will be incurred by the County of Los Angeles in conducting and consolidating the election and agrees to

reimburse the County for all election-related costs attributable to the City upon presentation of an invoice.

Section 7. In the event of a tie vote, if any two or more persons receive an equal and the highest number of votes for an office, as certified by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, the City Council shall, in accordance with Elections Code Section 15651(a), set a date, time, and place; summon the candidates who received the tie votes to appear; and determine the tie by lot.

Section 8. The Deputy City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution, enter it into the book of original resolutions, and promptly transmit the necessary resolutions to the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors and the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.

RESOLUTION NO. 6472

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THAT SAME DATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 10403 OF THE CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Maywood has called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 3, 2026, for the purpose of electing officers of the City of Maywood; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date; that the vote centers, ballot drop boxes, election officers, and election materials be the same where appropriate; that the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election; and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of the City of Maywood General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The offices to be voted upon, in the exact form requested for the ballot, are three (3) Members of the City Council, elected at-large, each for a full term of four years.

Section 2. Pursuant to the California Elections Code, the Los Angeles County Registrar of Voters is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and shall certify the results to this City Council. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used. The election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the statewide election.

Section 3. The Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to take all steps necessary to hold and conduct the consolidated election and to provide all election-related services requested by the City, including ballot preparation, vote centers, ballot drop boxes, vote-by-mail processing, canvass, and certification. The City Manager is authorized to execute any agreements or other documents with the County for such election-related services.

Section 4. The City of Maywood recognizes that costs will be incurred by the County by reason of the consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for all election-related costs attributable to the City upon presentation of an invoice.

Section 5. The Deputy City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Los Angeles County Registrar of Voters.

Section 6. The Deputy City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.

RESOLUTION NO. 6473

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR CANDIDATES FOR ELECTED OFFICE PERTAINING TO CANDIDATE STATEMENTS SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026

WHEREAS, § 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of any local agency adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for a municipal election, including costs of the candidate statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. General Provisions. Pursuant to Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California, each candidate for elective office to be voted for at an Election to be held in the City of Maywood on November 3, 2026, may prepare a candidate's statement on an appropriate form provided by the Deputy City Clerk. The statement may include the name, age, and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate. The statement shall not include party affiliation of the candidate, nor membership or activity in partisan political organizations. In addition to these restrictions, pursuant to Elections Code Section 13308, any candidate statement submitted shall be limited to a recitation of the candidate's own personal background and qualifications and shall not in any way make reference to other candidates for that office or to another candidate's qualifications, character, or activities. The Deputy City Clerk or the City Elections Official as determined by the City Council shall not cause to be printed, posted on an Internet Web site, or circulated, any statement that the Deputy City Clerk determines is not so limited or that includes any reference prohibited by this section. The statement shall be filed in typewritten form in the office of the City Clerk at the time the candidate's nomination papers are filed. The statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the period for filing nomination papers and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

Section 2. FOREIGN LANGUAGE POLICY.

- A. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, candidate's statements will be translated into all languages required by the County of Los Angeles. The County is required to translate candidate's statements into the following languages: Spanish
- B. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of translating the candidate statement into Spanish.

Section 3. PAYMENT

- A. The Deputy City Clerk shall estimate the total cost of the printing, handling, translating, and mailing of the candidate's statements filed pursuant to this section, including costs incurred as a result of complying with the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, and require each candidate filing a statement to pay in advance to the City of Maywood his or her estimated pro rata share as a condition of having his or her statement included in the voter's pamphlet.
- B. In the event an estimated payment is required, the estimate is just an approximation of the actual cost that varies from one election to another and may be significantly more or less than the estimate, depending on the actual number of candidates filing statements. Accordingly, the Deputy City Clerk is not bound by the estimate and may, on a pro rata basis, bill the candidate for additional actual expense or refund any excess paid depending on the final actual costs. In the event of underpayment, the Deputy City Clerk shall require the candidate to pay the balance of the cost incurred. In the event of an overpayment, the Deputy City Clerk shall prorate the excess amount among the candidates and refund the excess amount paid within 30 days of the election.

Section 4. Additional Materials. No candidate will be permitted to include additional materials in the voter information guide.

Section 5. The Deputy City Clerk or the City Elections Official as determined by the City Council shall provide each candidate or the candidate's representative a copy of this Resolution at the time nominating petitions are issued.

Section 6. All previous resolutions establishing City Council policy on payment for candidate statements are repealed.

Section 7. This resolution shall apply only to the election to be held on November 3, 2026, and shall then be repealed.

Section 8. The Deputy City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

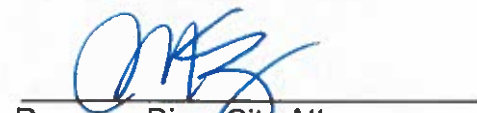
