

RESOLUTION NO. 26-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE CONSOLIDATED WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF SAID CITY AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES; REQUESTING THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO AGREE AND APPROVE SAID CONSOLIDATION; AND SETTING FORTH REGULATIONS FOR CANDIDATE'S STATEMENTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Palos Verdes Estates Municipal Code Section 1.20.010 and under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held in the City on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the election of three (3) Members of the City Council for the full term of four (4) years; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City the precincts, polling places and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the election department of the County of Los Angeles canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing this service shall be paid by the City of Palos Verdes Estates; and

WHEREAS, Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of the local agency adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for a municipal election, including costs of the candidate's statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALOS VERDES ESTATES, CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California, relating to general law cities within the State, there shall be, and is hereby called and ordered held in the City of Palos Verdes Estates, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, a General Municipal Election of the qualified electors of said City for the purpose of electing three (3) Members of the City Council for the full term of four (4) years.

SECTION 2. That the ballots to be used at said election shall be in form and content as required by law.

own personal background and qualifications and shall not in any way make reference to other candidates for that office or to another candidate's qualifications, character, or activities. Such statement shall be filed in the Office of the City Clerk, with payment of applicable fees, at the time the candidate's nomination papers are filed. Such statement may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the period for filing nomination papers and until 5:00 p.m., the next working day after the close of the nomination period.

B. Pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act, candidate's statements will be translated into all languages required by the County of Los Angeles. The County is required to translate candidate's statements into the following languages: Chinese, Korean, Spanish, Japanese, Vietnamese, Tagalog, Gujarati, Hindi and Thai.

C. The County will print and mail voter information guides and candidate's statements to all voters in Spanish and any other required translation languages to only those voters who are on the County voter file as having requested a sample ballot in a particular language. The County will make the sample ballots/voter information guides and candidate's statements in the required languages available at all polling places/voting centers, on the County's website, and in the Election Official's office.

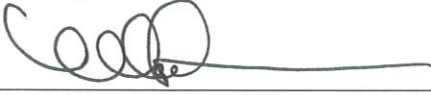
D. Translations:

1. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of translating the candidate's statement into any required foreign language as specified in (A) and/or (B) of Section 10 above pursuant to Federal and/or State law.
2. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of translating the candidate's statement into any foreign language that is not required as specified in (A) and/or (B) of Section 10 above, pursuant to Federal and/or State law, but is requested as an option by the candidate.

E. Printing:

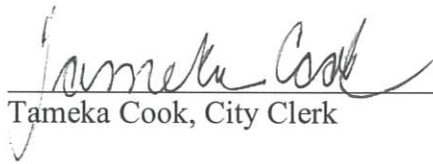
1. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidate's statement in English in the main voter pamphlet.
2. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidate's statement in a foreign language required in (A) and/or (B) of Section 10 above, in the main voter pamphlet.
3. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidate's statement in a foreign language requested by the candidate in the main voter pamphlet.
4. The candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidate's statement in a foreign language required by (A) and/or (B) of Section 10 above, in the facsimile voter pamphlet.

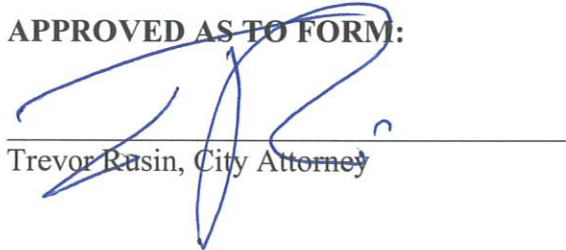

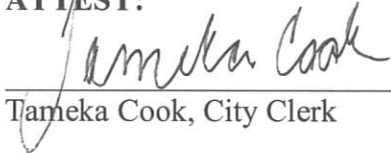
