

**SNOWLINE JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
RESOLUTION NO. 26-1808**

RESOLUTION ORDERING GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Education Code sections 5000-5030, the Snowline Joint Unified School District Board of Trustees is required to order a governing board member election for seats whose terms expire in November 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Office of Education issued Informational Bulletin No. 7112 regarding the November 3, 2026 Biennial Governing Board Member Elections; and

WHEREAS, the Snowline Joint Unified School District has one governing board seat scheduled for election in Trustee Area 1; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Snowline Joint Unified School District hereby orders an election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of electing one (1) member to the Governing Board representing Trustee Area 1 for a full four-year term.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the election shall be consolidated with the statewide general election to be conducted by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk in accordance with applicable provisions of the Education Code and Elections Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is authorized to perform all duties incident to the preparation for and conduct of the election, and the District shall pay its proportional share of election costs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board is directed to furnish certified copies of this Resolution to the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools and the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk in accordance with statutory timelines.
