

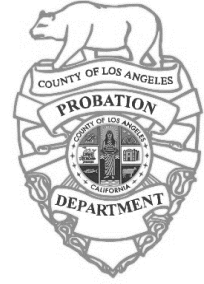

SUBJECT: **ENSURING SAFE LIVING CONDITIONS FOR PREGNANT,
JUSTICED-INVOLVED YOUTH (ITEM 50, BOARD AGENDA OF
NOVEMBER 4, 2026)**

On November 4, 2025, by motion of Supervisor Horvath, the Board of Supervisors (Board) directed the Chief Probation Officer, in collaboration with the Department of Mental Health, and Department of Health Services, to report back in writing at every regular Board meeting, as long as there are pregnant youth in custody, on the specific steps taken to secure alternative housing for pregnant youth in Probation's care, in collaboration with relevant County stakeholders as appropriate, including the Department of Children and Family Services, Public Defender, Alternate Public Defender, and District Attorney.

As directed by the Board, whenever there is a pregnant youth within a probation facility, we will provide a weekly status update on efforts to secure their placement to alternative housing.

STATUS OF PREGNANT YOUTH:

As of July 17, 2026, one pregnant youth is currently housed at Campus Vernon Kilpatrick (CVK).

Based on the information presented, the youth was not immediately eligible for release. A Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) meeting was held within 24 hours of intake to provide youth with direct support from the Department of Mental Health, Juvenile Health Court

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Services, and Los Angeles County Office of Education. The youth attended her court hearing and was not released, but has a subsequent hearing within 28 days.
