Parking Fee Waiver for 17th Annual Homeboy 5K Run/Walk

Homeboy Industries is a nonprofit organization based in Los Angeles, California, founded in 1988 by Father Greg Boyle. Its mission is to provide support and opportunities for formerly gang-involved and previously incarcerated individuals, helping them to rebuild their lives and reintegrate into society. Homeboy Industries offers a range of services, including job training and placement, education, mental health support, and legal assistance. It operates various social enterprises, such as a bakery, a café, a merchandise shop, and pet grooming business which provide job opportunities and work experience for individuals in their programs. The organization is known for its holistic approach to addressing the root causes of gang involvement and incarceration, focusing on compassion, respect, and empowerment to help people transform their lives.

On Saturday, September 19, 2026, Homeboy Industries will host its 17th Annual Homeboy 5K Run/Walk through historic Downtown Los Angeles where approximately 5,000+ runners, walkers, volunteers, and families are expected to participate in the 5K Race, Doggy Dash, and Kids Run. The morning will be begin outside of Homeboy Industries’ headquarters in Chinatown with a Expo/Festival celebration featuring artists,

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partners, and vendors from across Los Angeles County throughout the morning. Those joining and sponsoring the event will support the work of Homeboy Industries to continue their mission to provide training and support to formerly gang-involved and previously incarcerated people, allowing them to redirect their lives and become contributing members of our community.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors waive parking fees in the amount of \$1,060 for 212 vehicles at Lot 45 and \$1,540 for 308 vehicles at Lot 58, excluding the cost of liability insurance, on Saturday, September 19, 2026, for community members, sponsors, and staff attending Homeboy Industries' 17th Annual Homeboy 5K Run/Walk.
