Public Comment		Favor	Colin M campbell	V. GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT 3-Minute Public Comment Script (General Public Comment) "Good morning, Honorable Members of the Board. My name is Colin Campbell, representing ADAPPS Inc., speaking during the General Public Comment to synthesize our previous itemized proposals and align them directly with the governance, ethics, and transparency objectives of Measure G and its Ethics Commission. Across our earlier agenda submissions, we have laid out a comprehensive framework for deploying our most powerful artificial intelligence tool—the Stargate Initiative—backed by a total budget framework of \$238.5 billion to be fully rolled out by 2029 through a strategic joint partnership with Japan. This initiative operationalizes the very mandates championed by the Governance Reform Task Force under Measure G: embedding absolute transparency, high-tech accountability, and radical equity into County operations. To recap how this architecture addresses our ongoing agenda items: Item 32 (MLK Library): We proposed utilizing Stargate innovation budgets to establish an interactive educational AI hub featuring the NAACP, Black Panther, Saladin, and Abraham Lincoln models to promote cultural awareness and resilience against institutional racism. Item 35 (Family Visitation & DCFS): We introduced 'KathrynCare' and the Sacagawea AI Model to combat child trafficking, protect Native American youth, support family reunification via the YMCA, and connect directly with senior national security frameworks like the National War College. Item 36 (TEMIS Medical Upgrade): We advocated for Appendix 11 diagnostic applications, specifically integrating the Geronimo Apache medicine man model to provide holistic clinical evaluations across emergency medicine, police, and fire services. Item 38 (Local Health Emergency Termination): We highlighted that the Stargate framework was introduced on the exact day of the January 2025 fires—mirroring President Trump's national partnership and complying fully with California Senate Bill 896 to reform cultural protections for African American and Native American communities. By merging these visionary AI models with the anti-corruption, ethical oversight, and public integrity goals of the newly established Measure G Ethics Commission, Los Angeles County can transform from emergency crisis management into a global beacon of technological and civil leadership. Let us utilize these resources wisely, protect our most vulnerable children and communities, and honor the true promise of good governance. Thank you very much."
