Heal the Bay California Coastal Cleanup Day Parking Fee Waiver 2026

Coastal Cleanup Day is the world’s largest volunteer-driven environmental event, mobilizing millions of people globally to protect oceans, watersheds, and wildlife from plastic pollution. For 37 years, Heal the Bay has coordinated this monumental effort in Los Angeles County in partnership with the California Coastal Commission and the Ocean Conservancy. On Saturday, September 19, 2026, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, over 3,000 volunteers will gather to tackle the region's marine debris crisis. Participants will clean up more than 50 local sites, including coasts, rivers, parks, and dive or kayak locations. The event will build on last year's incredible impact, where volunteers successfully removed over 18,000 pounds of trash.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors direct the Director of the Department of Beaches and Harbors to waive \$33,800 in parking fees for approximately 2,600 volunteers and support staff at County-operated beach parking lots, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for the Annual Coastal Cleanup Day, to be held on September 19, 2026.
