ESTABLISHMENT OF A REWARD FOR THE MURDER OF ISAIAH VALLEJO

On Friday, July 3, 2026, at approximately 12:10 a.m., Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) deputies responded to a gunshot victim call in the 45500 block of 21st Street West in the City of Lancaster. Upon arrival, deputies found 23-year-old Isaiah Vallejo lying in the backyard suffering from gunshot wounds to the torso. The Los Angeles County Fire Department arrived and assessed victim Vallejo's injuries, and he was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Through witness accounts, investigators learned victim Vallejo and his cousin were attending a "flyer party" comprised of high school seniors and young adults. Late in the evening, victim Vallejo was confronted and subsequently assaulted by multiple males on the street outside the gathering, during which he sustained severe injuries to his face.

Victim Vallejo returned to the party, located his cousin, and the two decided to leave the gathering. While walking out of the home's rear yard, a minor altercation arose between victim Vallejo's cousin and unidentified party attendees. Immediately afterward, an unidentified suspect, described as a male, Black, wearing a light blue "Nike" hooded sweatshirt and ski mask, fired two shots at victim Vallejo. LASD investigators have not identified the suspect and are seeking assistance in learning his identity.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors establish the offer of a reward in the amount of \$20,000 in exchange for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of the perpetrator responsible for the heinous murder of 23-year-old Isaiah Vallejo on July 3, 2026, in Lancaster.
