Reward Extension in the Homicide Investigation of Murder Victim Terry Alford

On Friday, January 29, 2021, at approximately 5:00 p.m., Monrovia Police Department officers responded to reports of shots fired on the 100 block of Los Angeles Avenue in the City of Monrovia. Responding officers found 46-year-old Terry Alford in front of a residence suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Officers performed life-sustaining aid until the arrival of the Monrovia Fire Department at which time Victim Alford was pronounced dead at the scene.

Victim Alford was visiting his family and was on the front porch outside of the residence when four male suspects were seen walking up to the residence on video. At least two of the suspects snuck behind the victim and shot Victim Alford multiple times. Los Angeles Sheriff's Department (LASD) is assisting the Monrovia Police Department in the investigation. LASD detectives believe the shooting was intentional, but that Victim Alford was not the intended target.

Victim Alford is survived by his wife, children, and siblings. The family, who have been helpful during the investigation and remain in contact with investigators, are completely distraught by this senseless tragedy.

The \$10,000 reward approved by this Board on January 25, 2022, was extended on April 19, 2022 and is set to expire on October 21, 2022. LASD investigators are actively working on the case and believe the extension of this reward will encourage witnesses to come forward and provide information to this investigation. Any individuals with information about this crime are urged to contact the LASD Homicide Bureau or Crime Stoppers.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors extend the reward previously offered in the amount of \$10,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the perpetrator(s) responsible for the murder of 46-year-old Terry Alford.
