ORDINANCE NO. 2013-0006

An ordinance amending Title 22 – Planning and Zoning of the Los Angeles County Code to allow secondhand stores in the C-2 Zone, subject to certain development standards.

SECTION 1. Section 22.08.190 is hereby amended to read as follows:

22.08.190 S.

...

-- "Secondary highway" means a highway so designated on the Highway Plan, planned to serve an areawide or countywide transportation function, normally with four moving lanes of traffic on 80 feet of right-of-way, but which may have only two lanes of moving traffic in nonurban areas.

-- "Secondhand store" means a retail store established to collect and sell used household goods, clothing, and/or merchandise that are donated to the store. Secondhand store shall not include an antique shop, pawnshop, yard sale or junk and salvage use, or use involving the sale of used vehicles or vehicle parts. To the extent that a secondhand store sells tangible personal property, as defined in California Business and Professions Code ("B&PC") section 21627, the secondhand store must comply with all applicable requirements of the B&PC governing secondhand goods, including applicable registration and reporting requirements.

SECTION 2. Section 22.28.130 is hereby amended to read as follows:

22.28.130 Permitted uUses.

Premises in Zone C-2 may be used for:

A. The following commercial uses, provided all sales are retail only and all goods sold, except genuine antiques and items sold at secondhand stores, are new:

1. Sales

...

-- Retail Stores

-- Secondhand stores, subject to the applicable development

standards set forth at Section 22.28.170.

...

SECTION 3. Section 22.28.170 is hereby amended to read as follows:

22.28.170 Development sStandards.

Premises in Zone C-2 shall be subject to the following development standards:

...

F. Secondhand stores.

1. A residential use, accessory or otherwise, is prohibited on the same lot as a secondhand store, unless the residential use is within a mixed-use development that has a secondhand store and otherwise complies with Part 18 of Chapter 22.52 of this code;

2. The areas of a secondhand store for donation drop-off, sorting, storing, and distributing shall be located entirely within an enclosed building; and

3. A secondhand store shall post one wall sign, with a minimum of one square foot and a maximum of four square feet of sign area, notifying the public that donation drop-offs to the secondhand store during non-business hours are prohibited. The sign area for this wall sign shall not be included in calculating the maximum wall sign area permitted for the secondhand store under Section 22.52.880.A of this code.
