Commission Meeting CODE OF CONDUCT

The following Code of Conduct is operative during Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission Meetings and all are reminded to abide by the following rules:

- Speakers must cease speaking immediately when their time has ended;
- Public comment on agenda items must relate to the subject matter of that item;
- General public comment is limited to subjects within the jurisdiction of the Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission;
- Public comment does not include the right to engage in dialogue with the Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission members or staff;
- Please remain respectful of the forum and refrain from uttering, writing, or displaying profane, personal, threatening, derogatory, demeaning or other abusive statements toward the Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission, any member thereof, staff or other persons;
- Members of the audience should be respectful of the views expressed by the speakers, staff and Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission members, and may not clap, cheer, whistle or otherwise disrupt the orderly conduct of the meeting (you may raise the roof);
- A person engaging in conduct that disrupts the meeting is subject to being removed from the Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission Meeting.
